### **The Round-up!**

The top 6 current, clinically-relevant, accurate and accessible practical resources we found. Click on the items below to access the documents and/or websites.

1. CDC 2-page PrEP fact sheet for providers
2. SF City Clinic PrEP website and 3-page guidance (short and sweet, done with the AETC)
3. Johns Hopkins HIV acquisition risk calculator (clinical decision making tool)
4. New York State PrEP guidelines (shorter with more useful tables than the CDC guidance)
5. CDC PrEP website and guidelines (the authoritative guidelines but too long at 67 pages)
6. NCCC PrEPline (for live, real-time, customized help)

The best patient education materials were found at:

1. CDC: Talk to your doctor about PrEP
2. Project Inform: PrEP info for patients with videos, pamphlets, provider directory

A useful clinical check-list was created by Gilead, so we need a non-pharma version.

### **The analysis and proposed next steps**

Many of the websites found contained links and lists of the same or similar re-hashed guidelines and content on the background, concepts and rationale for PrEP. Recorded webinars were cumbersome to access and contained very little practical info for the amount of time needed to access and listen to them. There were few clinically practical tools and simple/short guidance available for busy clinicians and health care staff. New items are getting posted online often, so it would be helpful to continue to add items to the Google document to track new items.

Potential next steps:

- Refine and make the SF City Clinic / EB AETC 3-page guidance document relevant for all of CA
- One-page clinical PrEP checklist: create non-pharma, CDC guidelines-based one-page document
- Add and review new PrEP resources on the Google document
- Include our top picks for PrEP resources and trainings on an easily accessible webpage
- Develop an online forum for PrEP providers, maybe in collaboration with the NCCC
