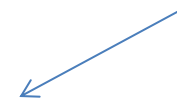


- 1) Order Baseline Viral Load and Genotype

- 6) APRI Score

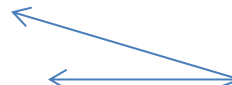

If GT 2-6

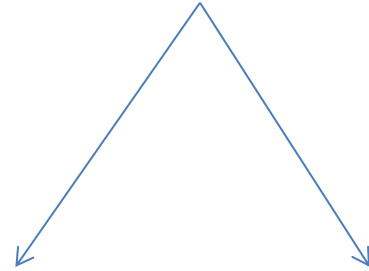
