### Year 8 – “Figures from Medieval realms in Europe”

**Create a research document**, either by hand or on the computer (or both) using the format below for your research. Remember that your research should focus on the **place** that you are from (name of village, town or city, geographical features particular to that place and its immediate surroundings); the place in relation to the known medieval European world and pilgrimage sites in Europe; the **persona** that you are (choose a typical medieval job or role for yourself that would have existed in Medieval Europe).

Make a <b>medieval style map</b> of the place you are from in relation to Geneva and to St. Maurice, the destination of our pilgrimage in May.		
Create an annotated <b>picture</b> of your persona, with a brief “ <b>autobiography</b> ” that is historically plausible (between 50 & 1,000 words)		
Think about <b>dress</b> (costume) <b>shoes, hairstyle, fabrics &amp; jewelry</b> that you might have been able to purchase and wear.
