Miami University Middletown scholarship awards vary from \$100 to \$5,000. Awards are made at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee based on the availability of funds.

SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Based on availability of funds, these awards may cover the costs of tuition, fees and books for one academic year.

Venus and Ruth Maupin Scholarship – Need and merit-based, enrolled full-time, have completed 24 credits on the Middletown campus, minimum 3.0 GPA, declared major, 3 letters of recommendation, interview may be required.

William C. and Mary E. Akers Scholarship – Preference to employees of Akers Packaging Company and immediate family members, need-based, enrolled full-time.

Isidor A. Casper Scholarship – History major, Middletown campus student, merit-based.

Miriam G. Knoll Non-Traditional Student Scholarship – Must be 22 years or older, enrolled full or part-time, need-based, reside in Butler, Preble or Warren Counties, working toward defined academic career goal.

Cynthia Yang Memorial Scholarship – Non-traditional student, need-based majoring in a math or science-related field, enrolled at least part-time at the Middletown campus.

ALUMNI

Miami University Alumni Association Middletown Chapter Scholarship – Need-based, 2.8 high school GPA or higher, preference for students who are graduates of one of 19 local high schools and whose parents attended or graduated from Miami University.

ART

Dean E. and Ethel Lorene J. Chenault Memorial Art Scholarship – Must submit a portfolio, interview required. Must be enrolled in an art class during the semester covered by the scholarship.

BUSINESS

Dale E. Converse Memorial Scholarship – Student majoring in business-related field.

Ryan K. Green Memorial Scholarship – Must have completed 12 hours on the Middletown campus, enrolled at least half-time, GPA of 2.75 or higher.

Bill and Barbara Howe Scholarship – Need-based. Middletown campus student residing in Butler, Warren, Preble, or Montgomery counties. Preference to students majoring in business administration or business-related field.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

MUM Community Service Scholarship – Need-based. Minimum 3.0 GPA or higher. Letter of recommendation from an official representative of a community service agency with Butler, Warren or Preble Counties.

ENGLISH

Malcom M. Sedam English Scholarship – Additional submission required. See departmental listing on our web page.

FULL-TIME STUDENT

William C. and Mary E. Akers Scholarship – Preference given to employees of Akers Packaging Co. and immediate family members.

MUM Faculty and Staff Scholarship – Full-time student with GPA of 2.8 or higher.

HISTORY

Isidor A. Casper Memorial Scholarship – Merit-based.

HIGH SCHOOL ATTENDED

Harry & Ethel Brakeman Memorial Scholarship – Entering freshman from Monroe or Middletown High School.

Earl David Passmore Jr. Scholarship – Entering freshman from Middletown High School. 2 letters of recommendation and an additional essay required, "Why I feel having a college education is important."

MATH OR SCIENCE

Cynthia Yang Memorial Scholarship – Need-based, non-traditional student majoring in a math or science-related field, attending the Middletown campus.

MULTICULTURAL

Gardner-Multicultural Merit Scholarship – Merit-based. For ethnic minorities including African Americans, American Indians/Alaskan Natives, Asian/Pacific Islanders, and Hispanics, enrolled full-time at the Middletown campus. GPA requirements for new (2.7 or higher), continuing (3.0), transfer (3.0) students. ACT score of 21 or higher or GED score of 57. Must participate in the MUM Mentorship Program.

Daniel Jeff Whitner, Sr. & Lillian Jean Whitner Minority Merit Scholarship – Minimum GPA of 3.0, participate in community and church activities.

NON-TRADITIONAL

Miriam G. Knoll Scholarship – Must be 22 or older, reside in Butler, Warren or Preble Counties, full or part-time.

Helen Peabody Scholarship – Full-time sophomores and above, must be 25 years or older and have at least a 3.0 GPA.

NURSING

Audrey Canfield Neel Scholarship – Need-based, full-time student in a health-related field.

RESIDENCE

Dillman Foods Scholarship – Preference to Dillman Foods employees and/or their families.

First Financial Bank Scholarship – (Butler, Warren, or Preble Counties) Preference to those working their way through college, married students with dependents and single parents.

Middletown Rotary Club Foundation Scholarship – Need-based. Students who have completed a minimum of 12 credit hours on the Middletown campus. Reside in greater Middletown, Monroe or Trenton area.

ALL SCHOLARSHIPS REQUIRE DOCUMENTATION AND RESPONSES TO THE FOLLOWING:

1. **Application for admission** to Miami University Middletown.
2. **Submit the FAFSA.** You can estimate taxes if necessary. FAFSA must be postmarked or electronically submitted by **FEBRUARY 15**.

3. **Submit scholarship application.** Scholarship application must be postmarked by **MARCH 1**.
4. **A letter of recommendation** (some scholarships require additional letters) from someone other than a relative who can speak to the applicant's character, qualities, and career aspirations. Strong letters have specific examples of a student's strengths. **The letter must be typed, signed and dated** and include the person's name, title, address, phone number, and relationship to the applicant. Give the recommender several weeks notice to write the letter.

5. **Submit a list and short description of activities, honors, awards, etc.** in school, church, employment, community, or other endeavors, which attest to your leadership and creativity. Include dates of involvement.
6. **On a separate sheet of paper, write a paragraph or two explaining your educational and professional goals.**
7. **Write a personal essay, approximately 300 words,** that gives reviewers additional insight about you not covered in other sections of the application. Examples might be life or job experiences, special skills, talents, or your motivation for seeking a scholarship.

Return all required materials (except recommendation letter) in a single packet to the Office of Student Financial Assistance. Materials must be postmarked by **MARCH 1.**
