This is actually a school contest which is a lot of fun. I like to do it around a reading celebration time (ie., Dr. Seuss' birthday).

I first announce it to each class (grades 1-4) and it is not mandatory. If the student wants to do it, they have to ask later for construction paper. When the posters are returned, I classify them by grade and post them on the walls by the library. After a couple of weeks, I make up a voting slip and the classes go around the the STUDENTS of the school vote on their favorite. The winners (usually 2 from each grade) receive books or any prizes you have.

I always show them an example (one that I have made).

Kids love it and it is fun.

Materials:

- * white construction paper

Rules:

1. Posters must have the title and author's name on them.
2. Posters have to be done by THE STUDENT (no older brothers or sisters!)
3. No tracing or copying...frechand drawings.
