

## **PLANIFICACIÓN DIDÁCTICA EN CLIL**

Fecha: 1<sup>st</sup> of October, 2009

Nivel: 2º      Unidad: 1. The senses.

### **OBJECTIVES.**

The children should develop the ability to:

- To know the organs of each sense.
- To know the senses of animals.
- To understand in an oral and written way, what the senses are.
- To produce short texts related to the senses.
- To reproduce orally details about the senses.

### **VOCABULARY.**

- Organs: eye, mouth, ear, nose and skin.
- Senses: Sight, taste, hearing, smell and touch.

### **MATERIAL.**

The used materials for this unit are flashcards, posters, real objects, internet, etc.

### **CONTENTS:**

Children at the age of 7 or 8 have already acquired knowledge about the senses and organs of the senses in Spanish so this topic is suitable to their age. There are many resources to use related to the topic so many visual materials are going to be used. The pupils are going to discover through experimentation in the classroom so the Science class will be very fun for them.

First, the teacher is going to practice the vocabulary with the children with the help of mime, gestures or flashcards. This is going to be repeated many times so the children can interiorize the input. All the contents are related to previous contents in L1 so the children should not have problems.

### **ARRANGEMENT.**

The children are going to work by themselves and in small groups depending on the task.

### **ASSESSMENT.**

Assessment will be individual. They will have oral and written assessment.

### **SESSION.**

#### Samples of tasks.

1. Look at the flashcards and repeat! The children look at the flashcards and repeat the words. Then, the teacher says some words and they have to draw them in their notebooks,
2. Listen and sing! The children listen to a song related to senses and sing it.
3. Science is fun! The teacher gives some real objects to the children and they touch, smell, taste them...
4. Write the word. The children have some pictures and they write the correct word.
5. Wordsearch. The pupils do a wordsearch about the topic.
