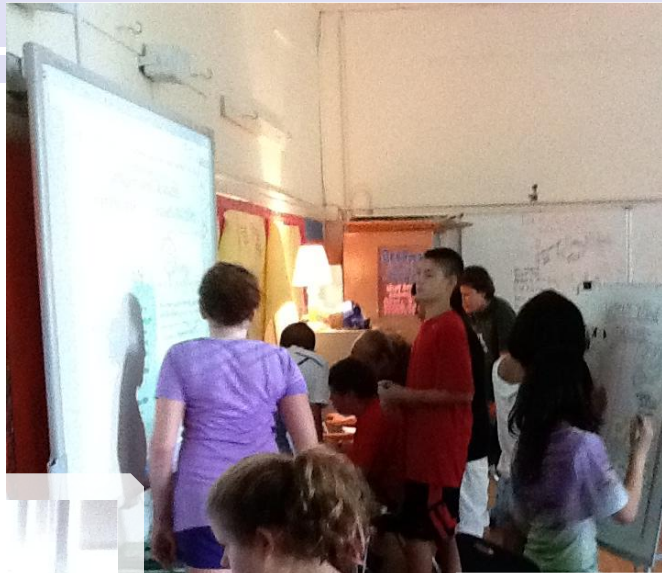

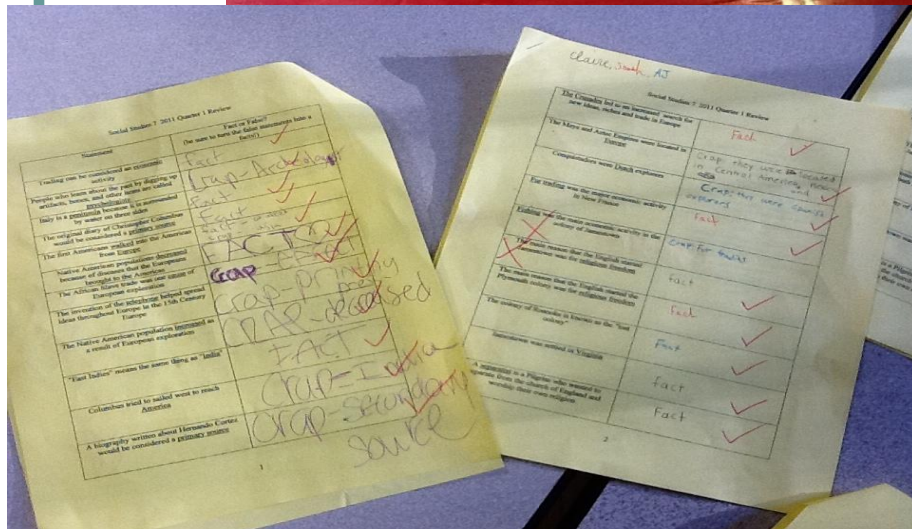


# Collaboration:
