Driving to Calgary Campus from Olds

- The drive is approximately 90 km; a minimum drive time will be one hour depending on Calgary traffic.
- Leaving Olds you have the choice of driving east to Highway 2 and turning southbound for Calgary, or traveling south on Highway 2A. Both options will have you entering Calgary on Deerfoot Trail.
- Once in Calgary remain on Deerfoot Trail, turning right to take Memorial Drive westbound.
- Continue west on Memorial Drive, merging right to take the 4th Avenue Flyover to cross the river into downtown Calgary.
- Continue west on 4th Avenue SE, then turn left to head southbound on 1st Street SE.
- Continue eight blocks south on 1st Street, until 12th Avenue where you will turn left.
- Continue eastbound on 12th Avenue for three blocks. You will turn right to head south on Olympic Way.
- Continue on Olympic Way for two blocks before turning left on 14th Avenue SE. The Calgary Campus is two blocks east.
