Accessing the Curriculum & Videos

Once you have received an e-mail from i-SAFE with your Username and Password, the curriculum is waiting for you on your personal online My Info page. Follow these steps to access your My Info page and the i-SAFE curriculum:

At the upper right hand corner of any i-SAFE Web site page, log in with your Username and Password. You will automatically be taken to your personal My Info page.

- Find the Curriculum section on your My Info page.
- Select a grade level.
- Choose a curriculum topic.
- Click to download the curriculum.

Or

- Find the Video section on your My Info page.
- Select and watch a Video. (Some Users may view a message about an HTTPS connection. If you see this warning message, please select "No".)

Professional Development Training

Registration Instructions

You have two ways to register with i-SAFE. **Option A** is for school district administrators to register all educators at one time through an i-SAFE STAT (Student Teacher Action Table). **Option B** is Online Registration which allows each educator to input their own information; this process takes only about one minute. See instructions below:

Option A - STAT Registration Instructions

As a School District Administrator, you can download a STAT and register all educators at one time. This spreadsheet format collects all the information we require to setup security access to our materials.

When submitting your STAT to i-SAFE, please indicate if you would like i-SAFE to send the password information directly to your educators, or if would you prefer i-SAFE to send the information to you for delivery. Each school district has established protocols about directly contacting staff and we desire to stay within your established procedures.

Option B - Online Registration Instructions

You have been designated by PAIUnet as an i-SAFE educator, which will allow you online access to grade-specific lesson plans. It is necessary for you to create an account with i-SAFE, by completing a few questions (a process that will take less than 1 minute).

Register with i-SAFE

- Please register now at: <https://auth.isafe.org/subscription/registration>
- To begin, enter Subscription Code: **(IVC 5 digit #)**
(If you have questions about this code, please contact your district, your Intermediate Unit, or Eric Rosendale at 724-774-7800)
- Select your State: Pennsylvania, then click "Next".



- You will be asked to agree to i-SAFE's Terms of Service. Please select "Yes".
- Then complete all fields of the questionnaire and be sure to click Submit when you are finished.
- An **i-SAFE** account will automatically be created for you. Click on the link provided to retrieve your Username and Password.
- An e-mail will immediately be sent to you containing your new Username and Password. Use that account information (Username and Password) to access the curriculum through the **i-SAFE** Web site.
