



Readers' Guide Select

100% full-text database containing indexing, abstracting and full text of 200 of the most popular general-interest periodicals published in the United States and Canada. Among the topics covered are current events, hobbies, politics, business, sports, recreation, news, cooking, popular music, entertainment, transportation, travel and more.



Science Full Text Select

100% full text database covering the sciences. Includes the full text from 360 journals from Wilson's Applied Science, Biological & Agricultural, and General Science databases, as well as science related articles from other Wilson databases.



SIRS Discoverer

Includes full text articles and images from over 1,600 domestic and international newspapers, magazines and government documents. Articles are assigned a reading level - easy, moderate or challenging - based on age-appropriateness, educational content, interest and reading level. This database is an excellent student resource.



Teacher Reference Center

Index of over 260 titles from the most popular teacher and administrator trade journals, periodicals and books. This database covers key education topics such as Assessment, Continuing Education, Curriculum Development, and more.

How to Access the POWER Library Databases

1. Go to your local library's website and click on the POWER Library icon:
2. When requested, type in your library card number. Please contact your library if the number is not working or if you do not have a library card.
3. Subjects are shown by Resource Blocks. Click on a database under a Resource Block.
4. Type in your search term and then scroll down the page to select search options. Clicking full text indicators, searching for related words, or searching within the full text of the article will enhance your search on most databases. Enclosing a string of words within quotation marks will ensure that search results deliver items with that exact phrase.
5. Click the search button, click go or press enter to activate your search.
6. Some databases may ask you to select additional options in lieu of entering search terms.
7. Results may be printed, emailed or saved to disc.

POWER Library Resources

The POWER Library is a service of Pennsylvania's public libraries, school libraries and the State Library. The POWER Library provides access to thousands of full text periodical articles, newspapers, a major encyclopedia, plus photographs, pictures, charts, maps, and reference materials for people of all ages.



ABI/INFORM

Offers full text titles covering trade and industry news. In-depth coverage of companies, products, executives, trends and other topics.



Access PA Contemporary Authors

Contains 136,290 entries on writers of fiction, nonfiction, poetry, journalism, drama, motion pictures and television.



Access Pennsylvania Database

Catalog holdings of over 3,000 Pennsylvania school, public, academic and special libraries are included in this database. Search by author, title, subject or keyword to locate over 70 million items.



AP Images

More than 500,000 current and historical photographs and graphics can be searched by date, place and subject. More than 800 photographs are added to the archive daily.



Auto Repair Reference Center

Supplied by Point 5 Technologies. This database contains complete automotive repair information by Nichols Publishing, publisher of Chilton information. Most major manufacturers of domestic and imported vehicles are listed. Repair information is available for most manufacturers as far back as 1945.



Consumer Health Complete

Provides content covering all areas of health and wellness from mainstream medicine to the many perspectives of complementary, holistic and integrated medicine. The full-text database covers topics such as aging, cancer, diabetes, drugs & alcohol, fitness, nutrition & dietetics, children's health, men & women's health, etc.



Career Library

A comprehensive information resource for career and college research. Included in this resource is over 2,500 occupations and nearly 4,000 2 and 4 year Colleges and Universities. Surveys and Assessments, based on the 16 federal career clusters, and an Occupational Video Library are also available.



GreenFILE

Offers information covering all aspects of human impact to the environment. Its collection of scholarly, government and general-interest titles includes content on the environmental effects of individuals, corporations and local/national governments and what can be done at each level to minimize these effects. Topics covered include global climate change, green building, pollution, sustainable agriculture, renewable energy, recycling and more.



InfoTrac Newsstand

This full-text newspaper resource allows users to search articles instantly by title, headline, date, author, newspaper section or other fields, eliminating random searching through newspaper archives. InfoTrac Newsstand provides access to more than 1,000 major U.S. regional, national and local newspapers as well as leading titles from around the world.



LISTA

A world-class bibliographic database that provides coverage on subjects such as librarianship, classification, cataloging, bibliometrics, online information retrieval, information management and more. LISTA indexes more than 600 periodicals plus books, research reports and proceedings. With coverage dating back to the mid-1960s, it is the oldest continuously produced database covering the field of information science.

Electronic books (ebooks) are available through this link. NetLibrary ebooks are full text searchable and available for use on personal computers in online format.



OmniFile Mega

Multi-disciplinary full-text database covering Art, Education, Social Sciences, the Humanities, Business, Science, Current Events, and more. Contains Indexing and Abstracting of 4000 journals, with full text from more than 2500 journals. Includes full text from 1995 forward and indexing from 1982 forward.
