

Google Image Search

Google provides the capability to allow students to just search images.

To use Google Image Search follow these steps:

1. Go to www.google.com
2. Click the “Images” link.
3. Enter the desired keyword(s)
4. Click the “Search Images” button. When the search is complete you will see a page of thumbnail pictures (or a number of pages).
5. In the results page, you can filter the image type.
 - a) Locate the menu options on the left of the page.
 - b) Click the size of the image, type of image and color that you are looking for.
6. Click the image you would like to see.
7. On the right of the screen “see full size image” to make the image appear in full size on the screen. (Note on the right side you will usually see a note regarding copyright. Make sure to follow the copyright requirements when using pictures from the Internet. Credit must be given for use of the picture. (Copy and Paste this link in your browser to learn how to site an image http://www.ehow.com/print/how_4586049_cite-online-image.html/).
8. To save the image to your computer, right click on it and select save picture as and choose where to save it on your computer. It will then be available for retrieval. Make sure to give credit to the site that the image came from. You will notice
