**The Richard Hagen-Minerva Harvey Memorial Scholarship**  
**Application deadline: March 15, 2012**

**Program:**

- The Richard Hagen-Minerva Harvey Memorial Scholarship program is for enrolled members of an American Indian tribe. Once approved, recipients will be authorized to receive up to 4 years of funding depending on year of attendance.
- Funds are to be used for students attending a public or non-public accredited university, college or technical institute located in South Dakota.
- Up to seven scholarships may be awarded each year.
- Annual scholarship award amounts include a minimum of \$1,000 for the first two years of attendance, a minimum of \$1,500 for the third year of attendance, and a minimum of \$2,500 for the fourth year of attendance.
- Scholarship recipient must be enrolled the equivalent of at least fourteen (14) credit hours per semester and maintain a cumulative 2.5 grade point average during the course of the scholarship period.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Graduation from an accredited South Dakota high school.
- Apply within 5 years after high school graduation or within 1 year after release from active military duty (if that release is within 5 years of high school graduation);
- Be an enrolled member of an American Indian Tribe.
- Must attend a public or non-public accredited university, college or technical institute located in South Dakota.

- Two letters of recommendation
- An official current high school transcript
- An official current college/post secondary transcript for any college/postsecondary study previously undertaken
- Verification of tribal enrollment
- An essay explaining why you deserve to receive a Hagen-Harvey Memorial Scholarship
- Listing of high school and/or college involvement in organizations and activities
- ACT scores

**Application Deadline:** Application deadline is March 15, 2012. Applications must be hand delivered by 5:00 PM CST or postmarked by the stated deadline.
