Apply Now For Your Chance To Win!

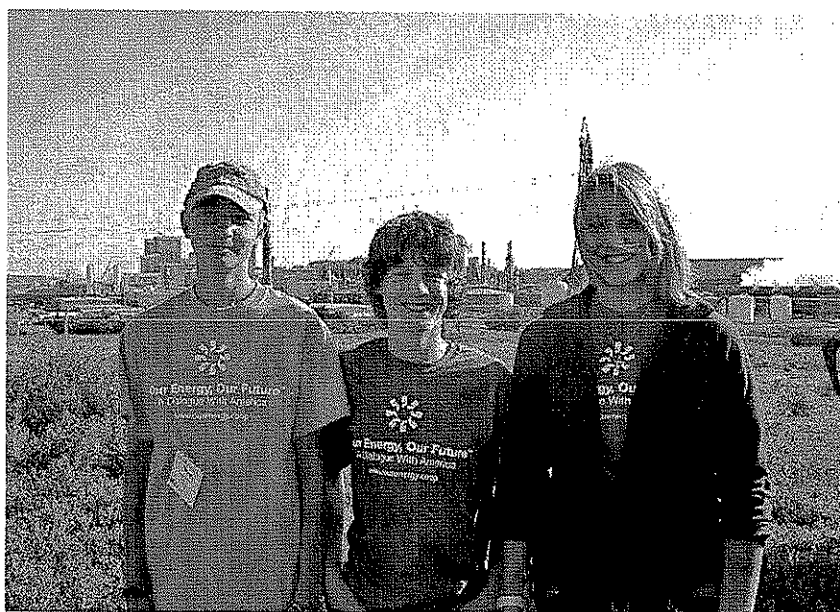
Cam Wal Electric and other rural electrics around the state are sponsoring a Youth Excursion again this summer.
