



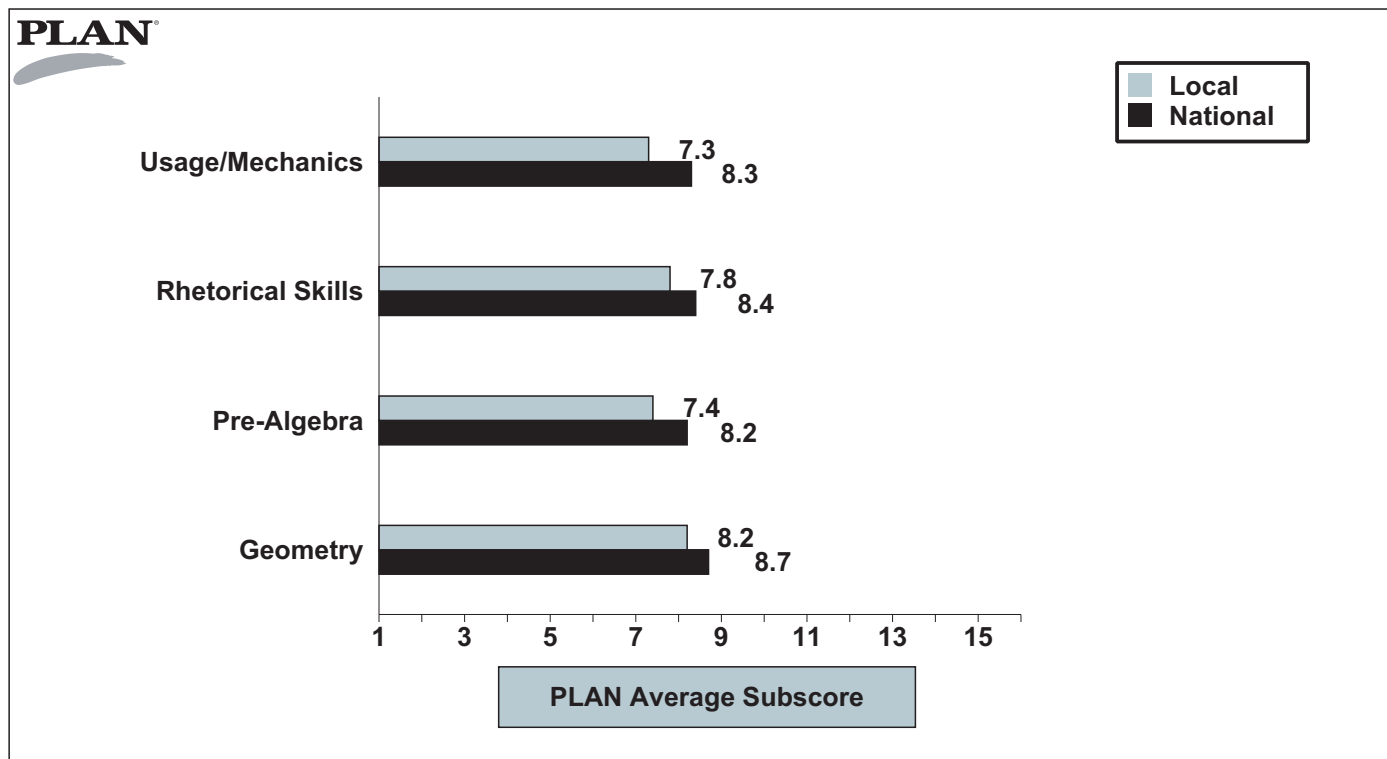
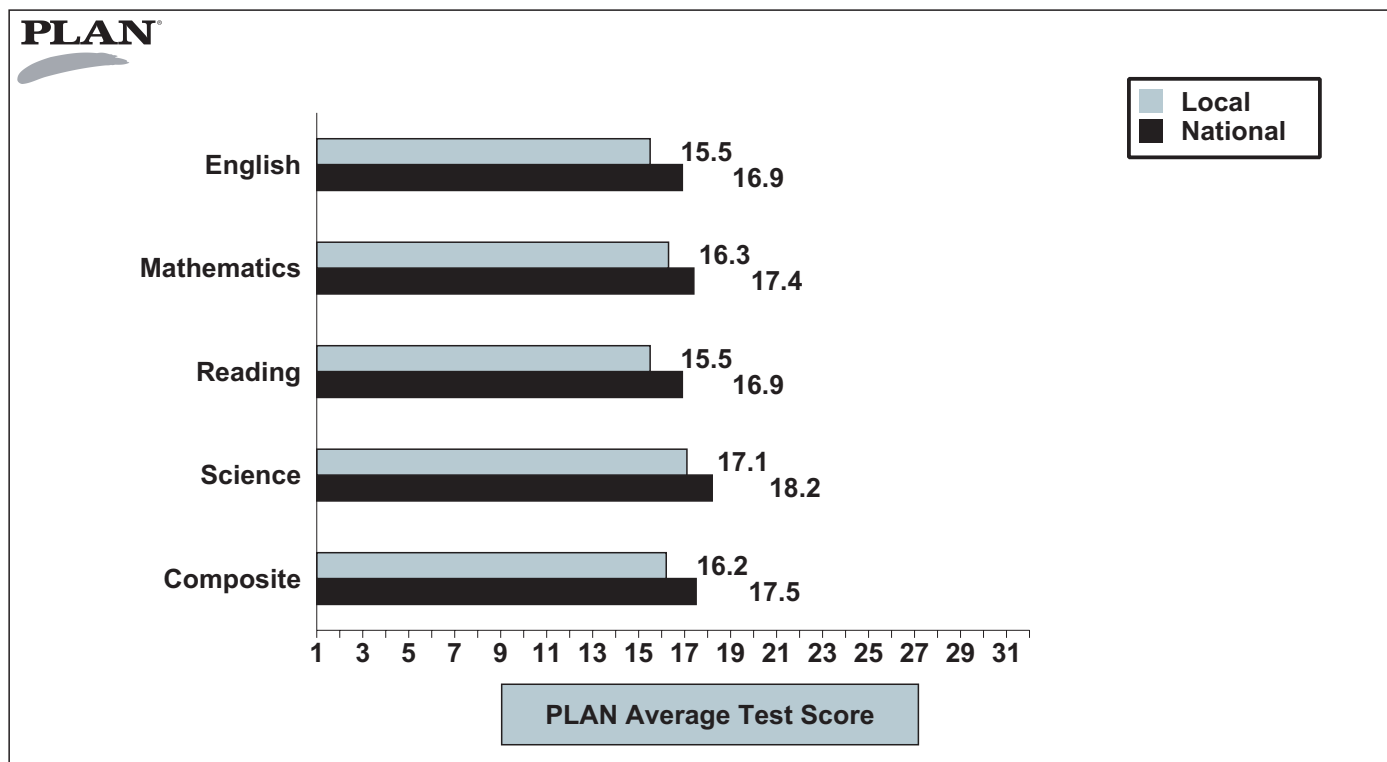

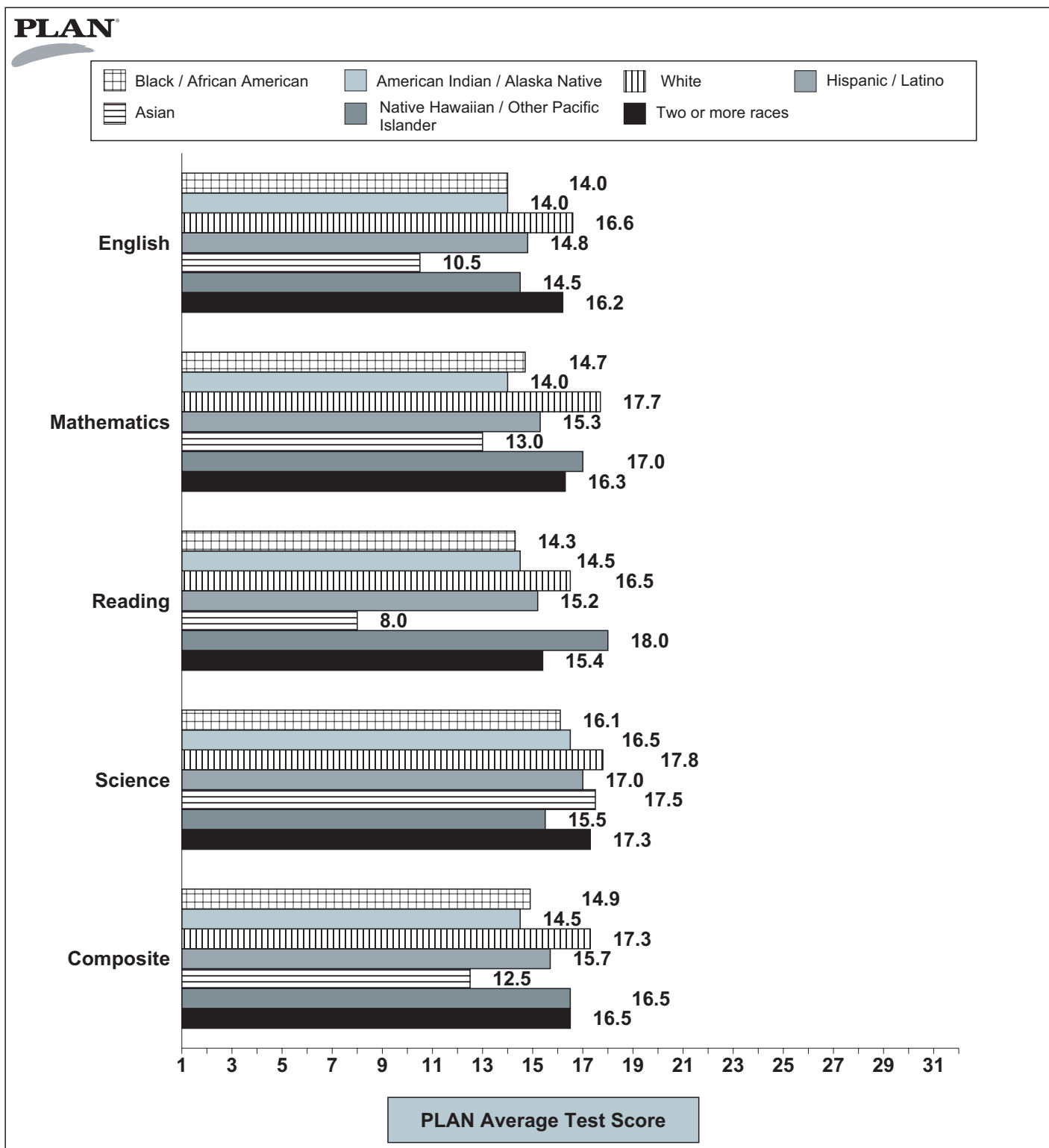

CHART 1: How does our students' performance compare with that of students in the national norm group?



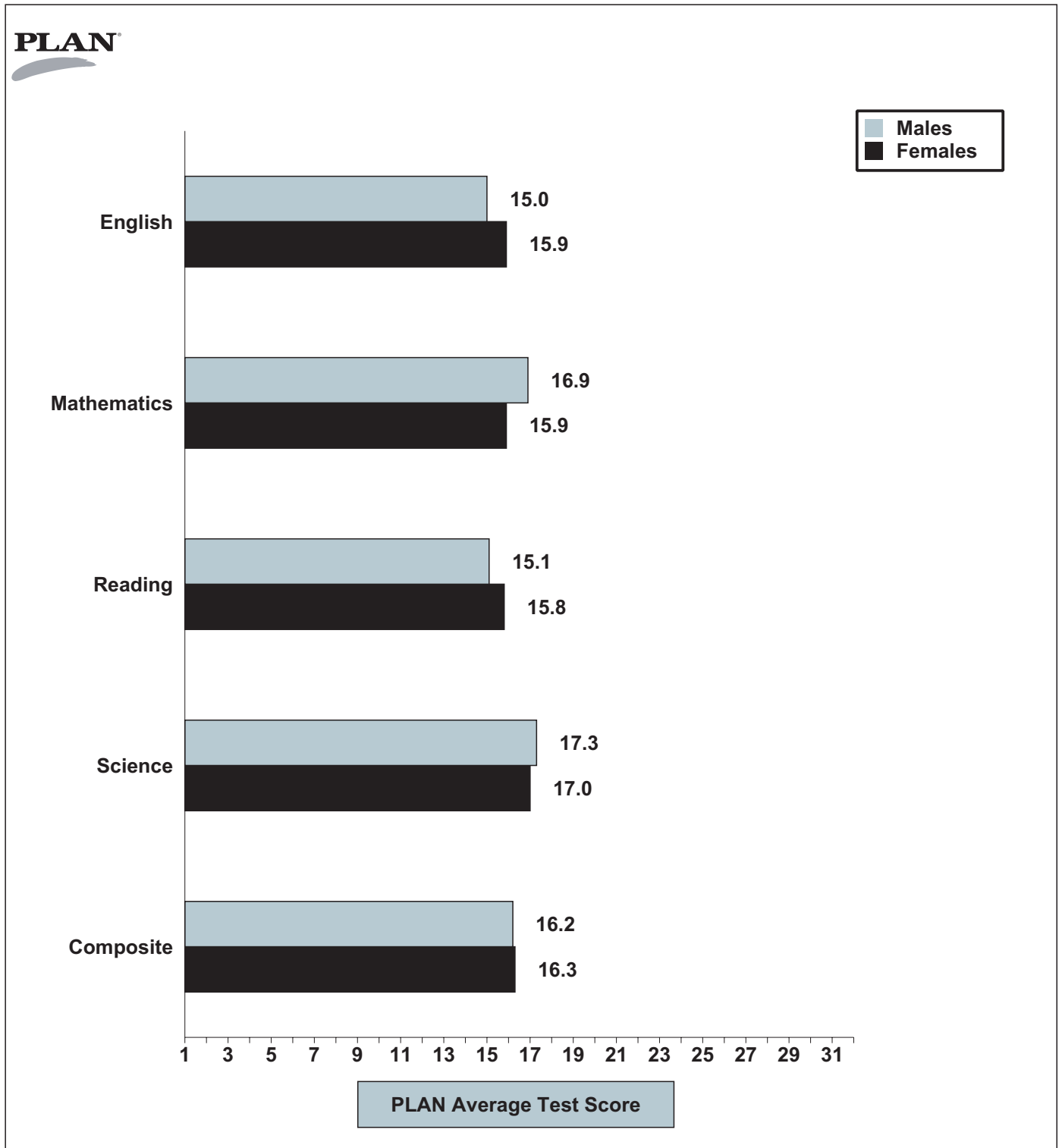
These charts show how the average score performance of our students compares with that of students nationwide.

CHART 4a: How do our students' English scores relate to the English courses they have taken or are currently taking?

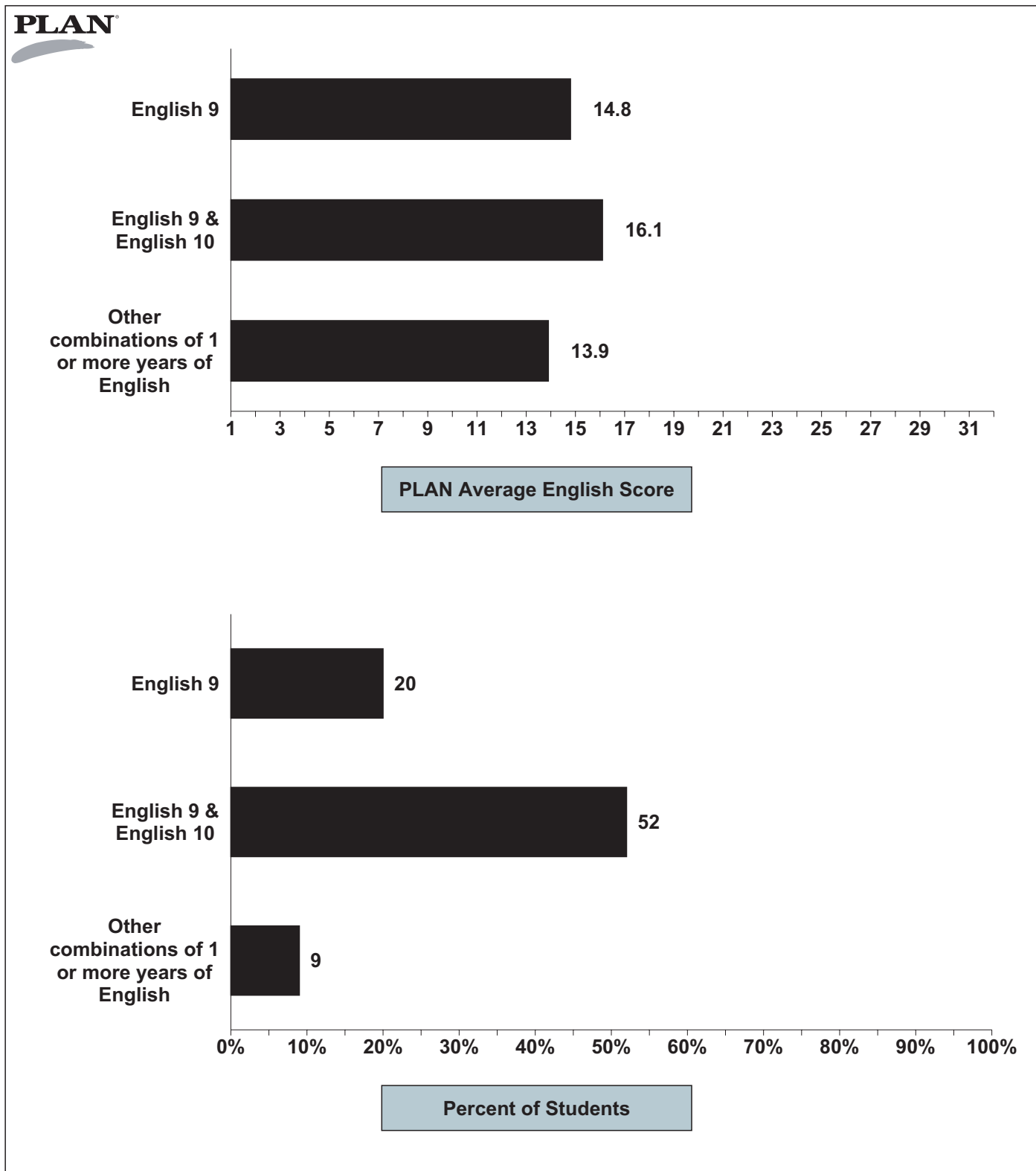


CHART 4b: How do our students' Mathematics scores relate to the mathematics courses they have taken or are currently taking?

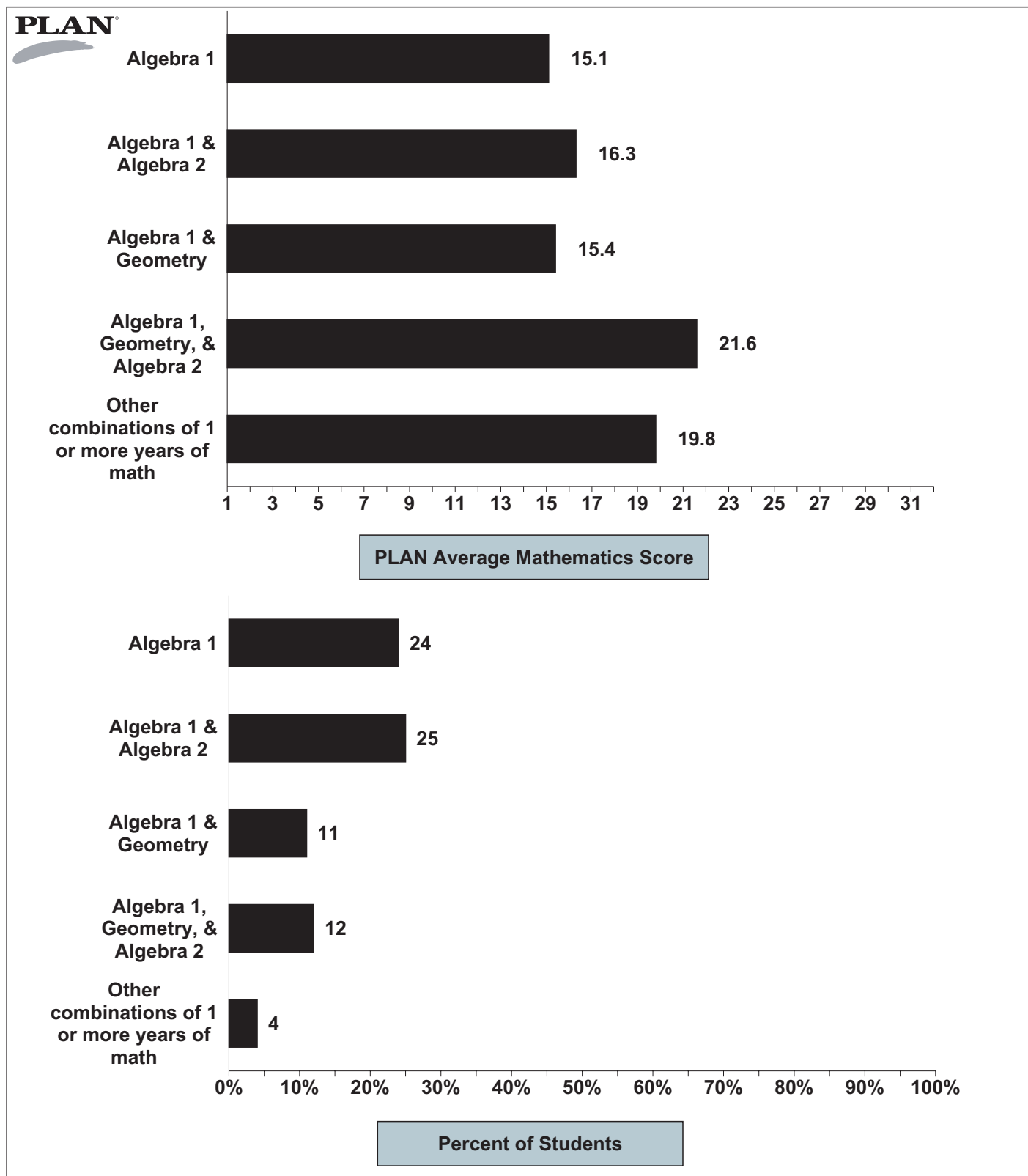


CHART 4c: How do our students' Reading scores relate to the social studies courses they have taken or are currently taking?

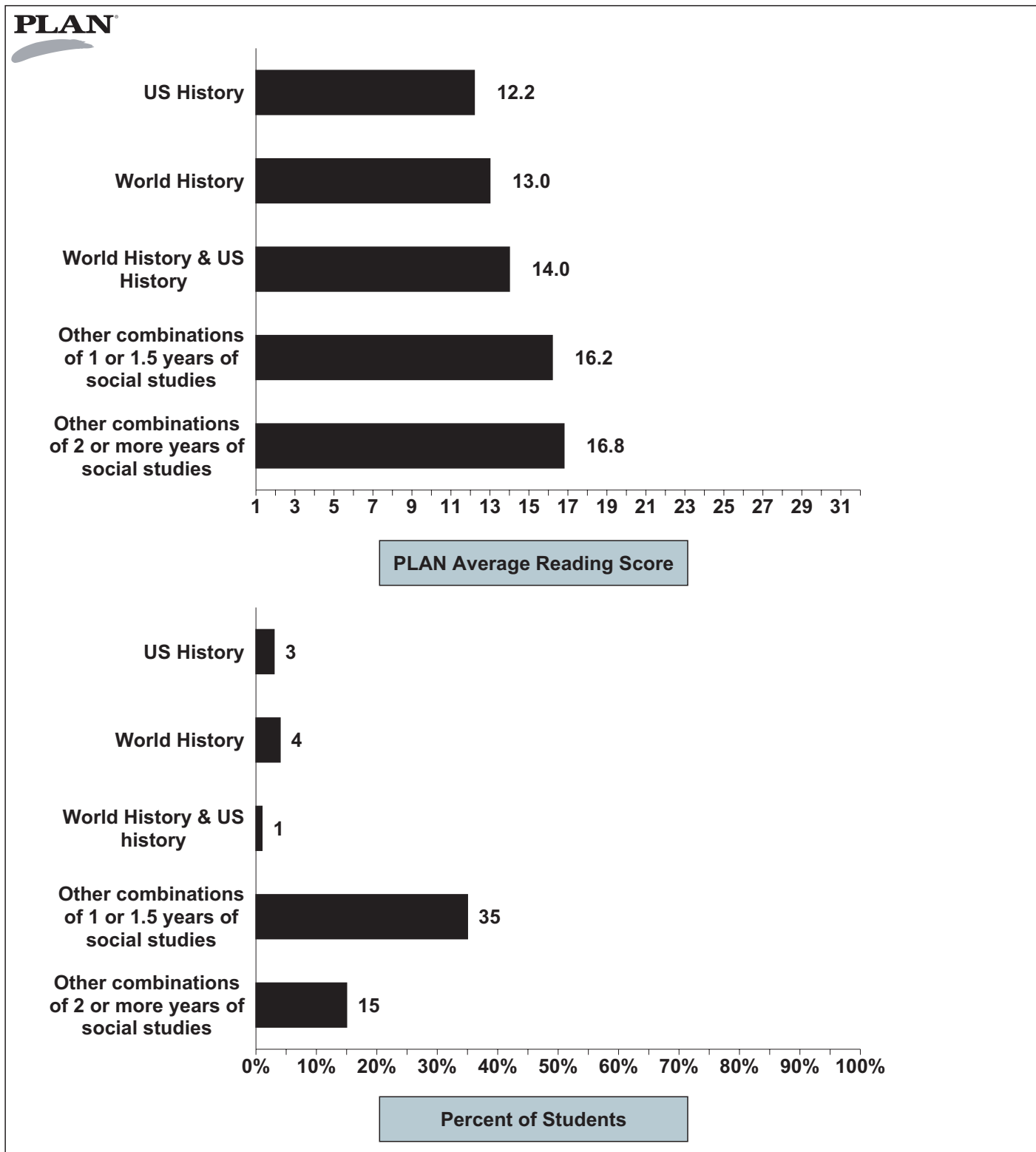


CHART 4d: How do our students' Science scores relate to the natural science courses they have taken or are currently taking?

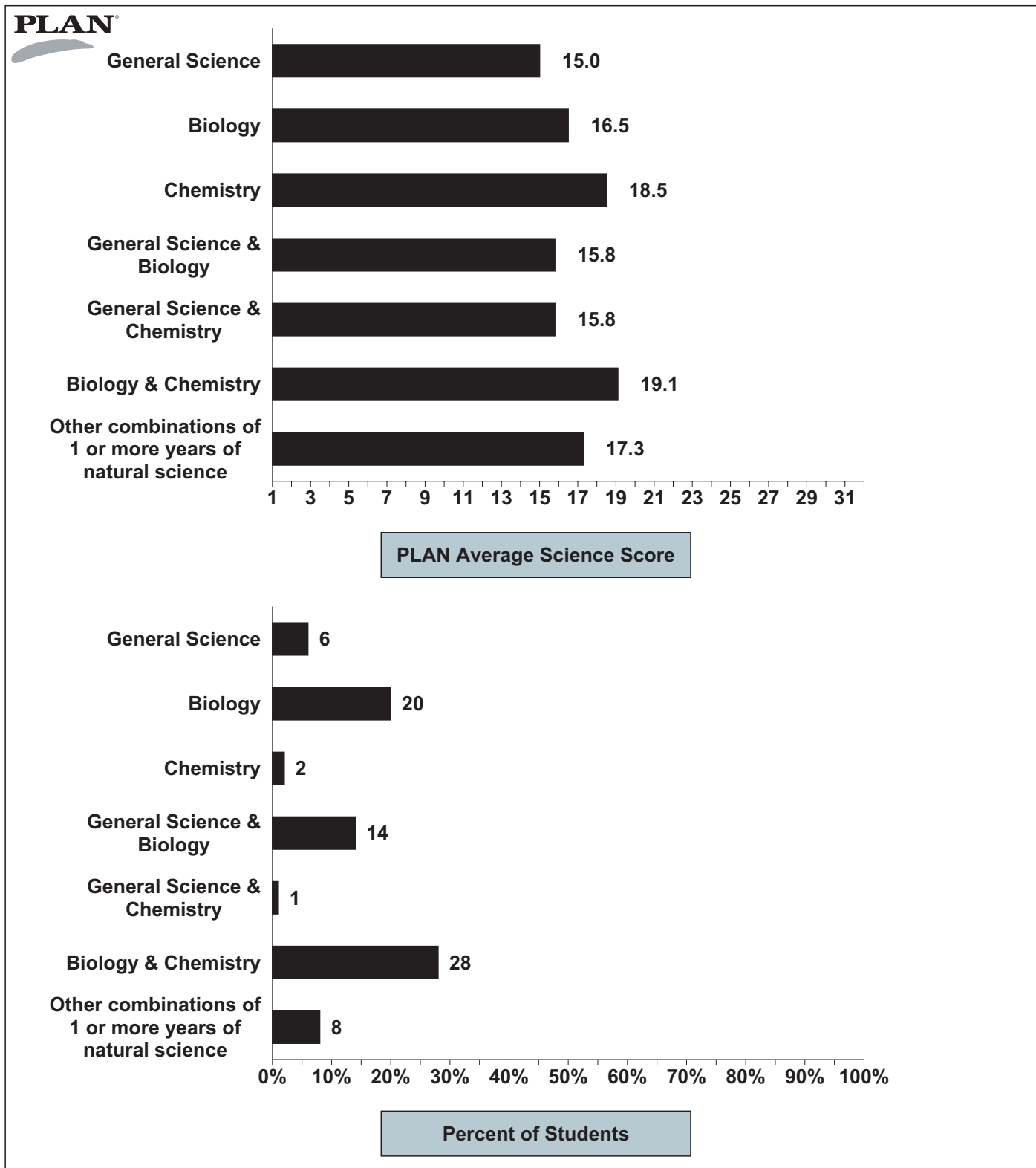


CHART 4e: How do our students' scores relate to the courses they have taken or are currently taking?

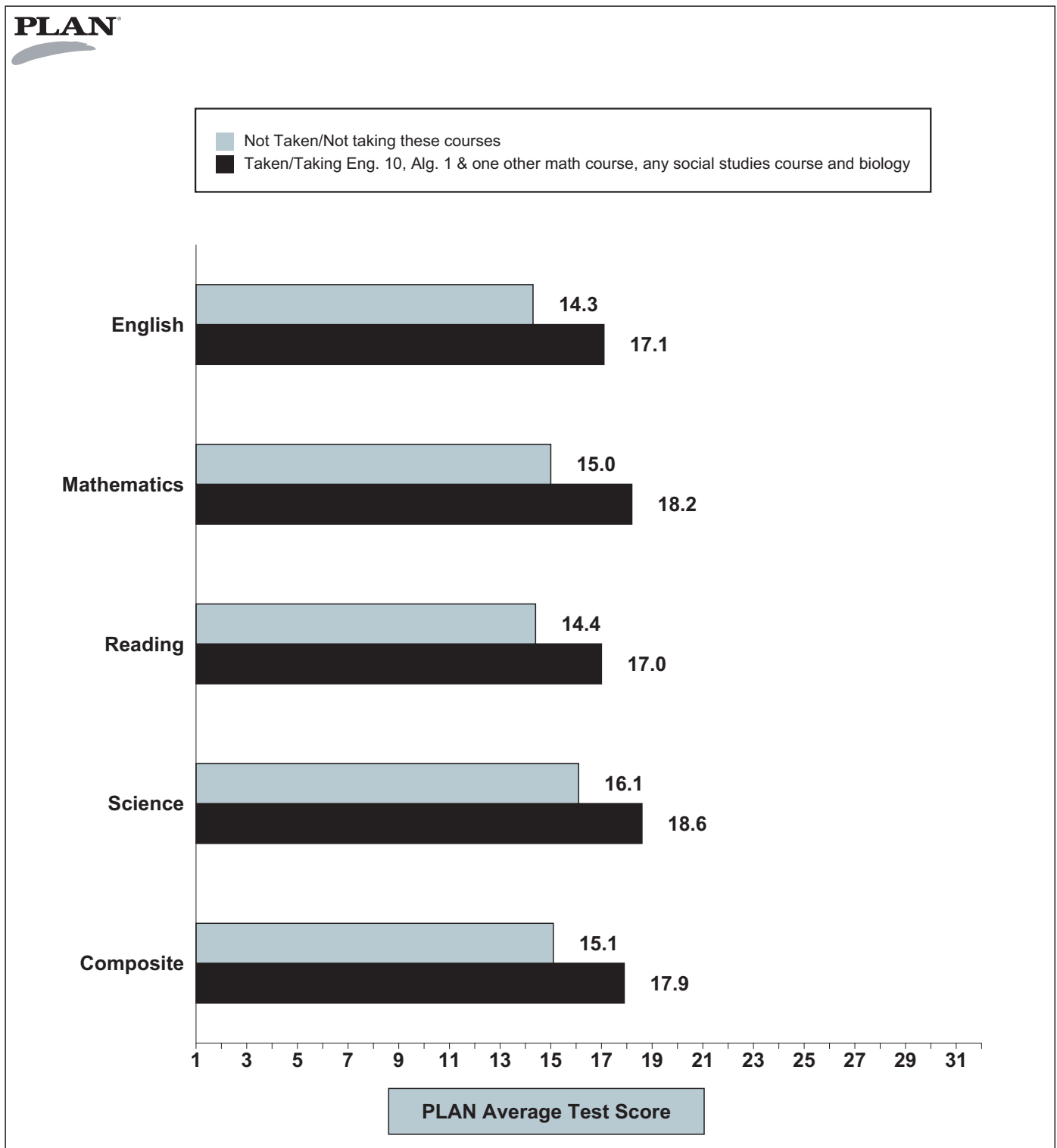
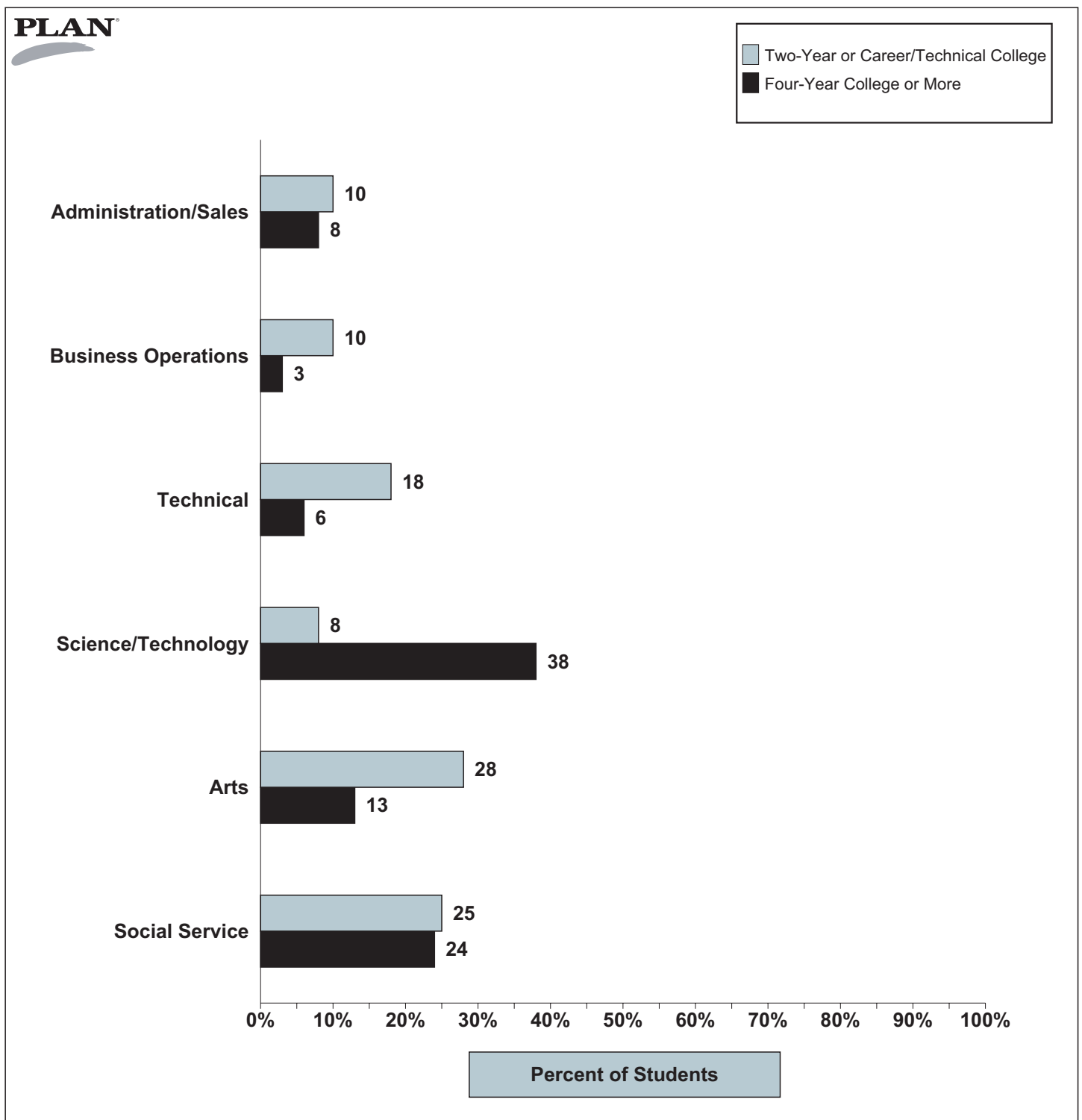
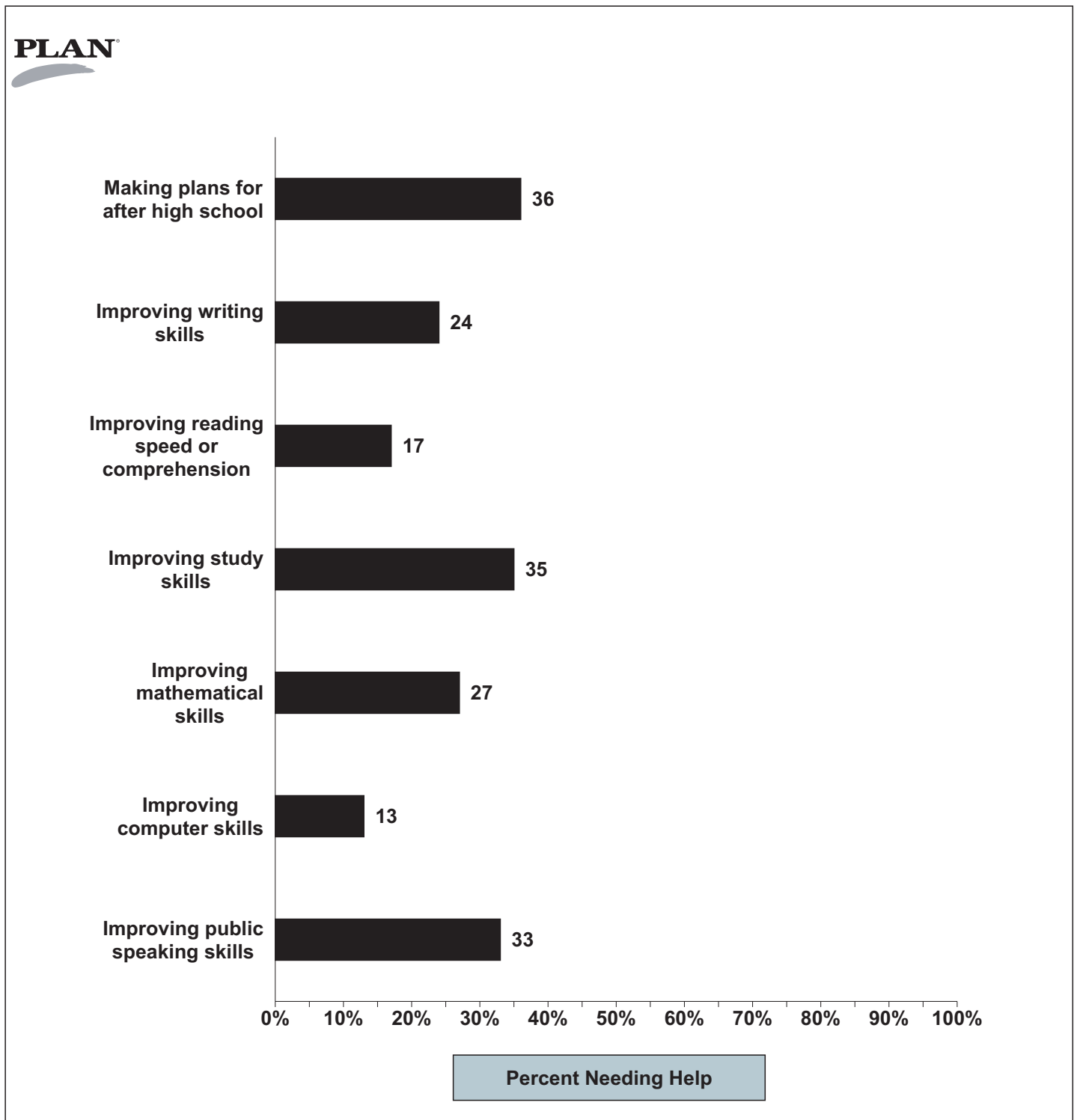


CHART 5: How do our students differ in their career preferences?



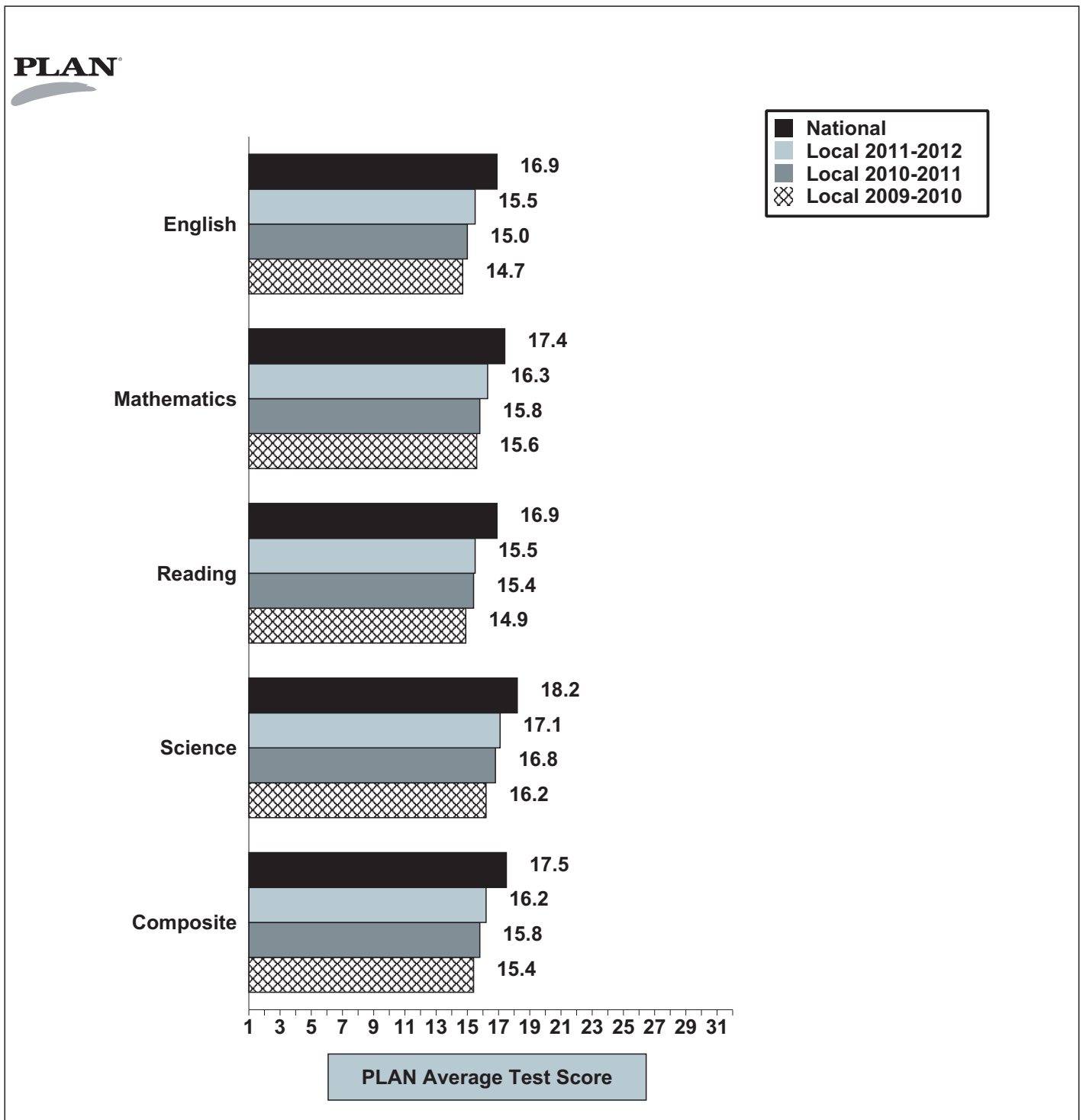
This chart compares the career preferences of our students who plan to attend either a two-year or career/technical college with those who plan to attend at least a four-year college.

CHART 7: Is the academic achievement of our students for the past three years improving compared to that of the national norm group?

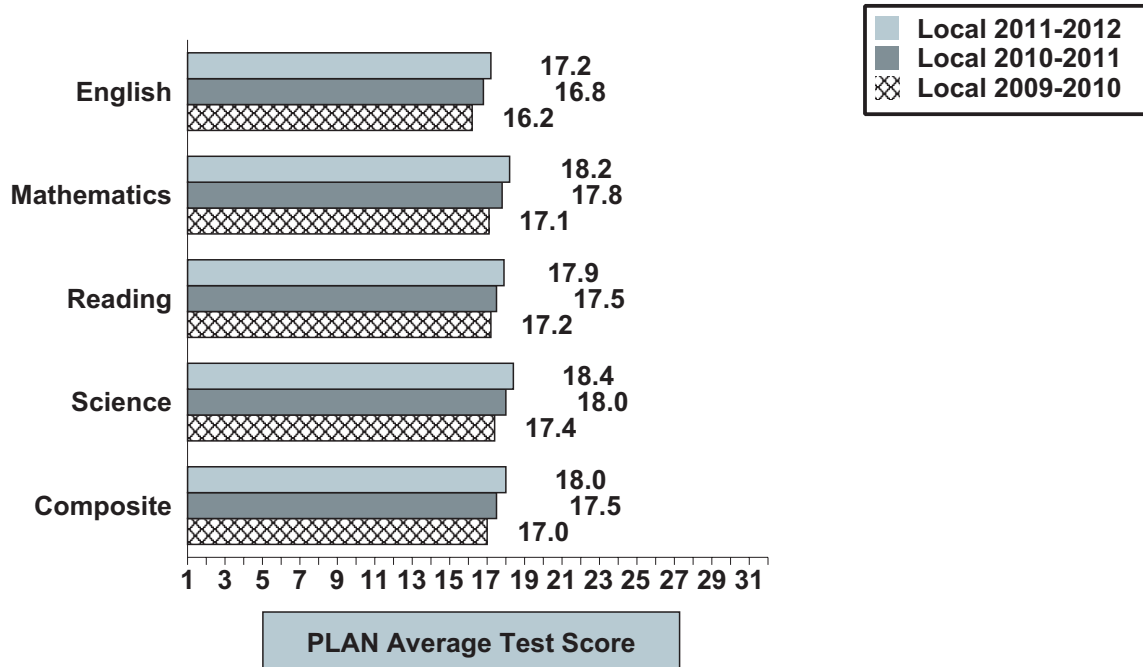


This chart shows the average performance of our students for the past three years.

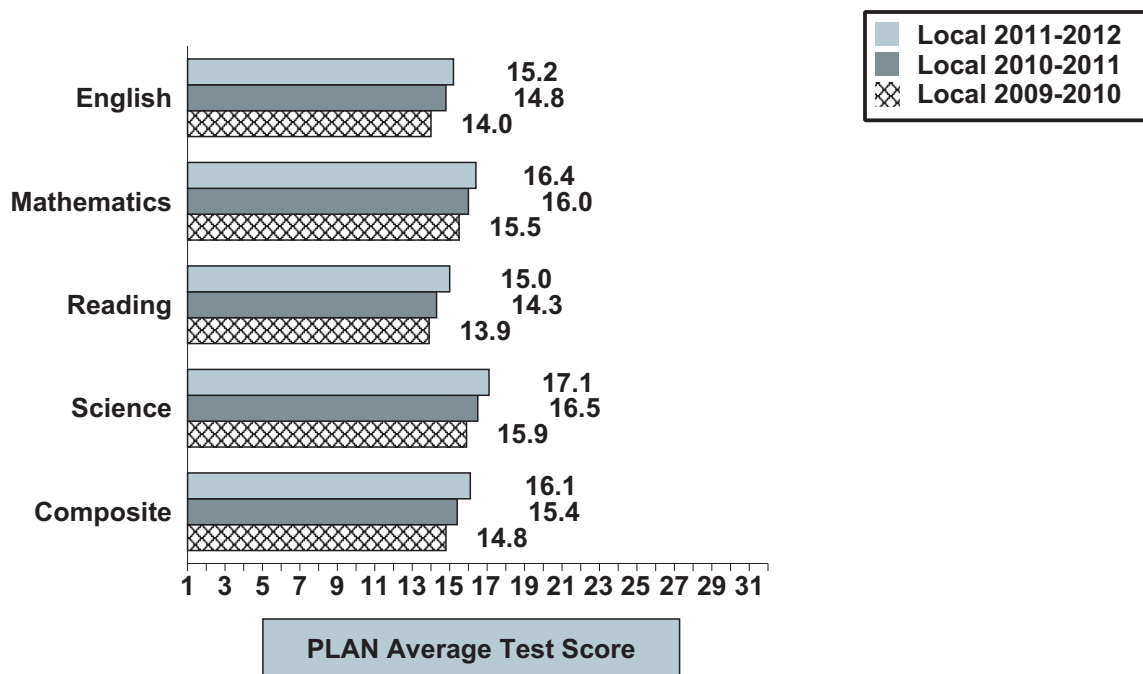
CHART 8: Are our students adequately preparing themselves to be successful?
