

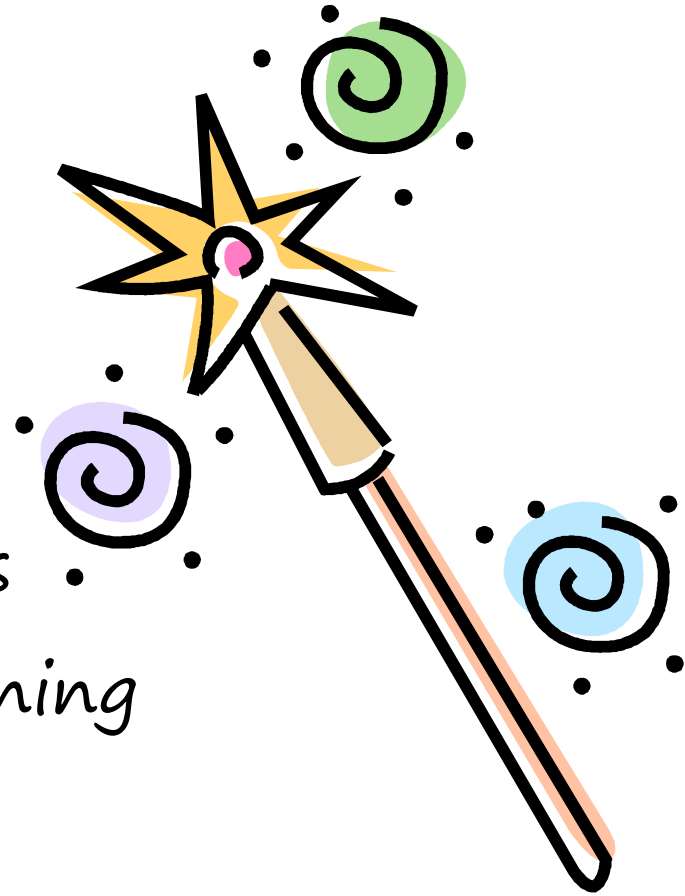
Thinking Skills:

- Trying out new roles in a group and making decisions as a group



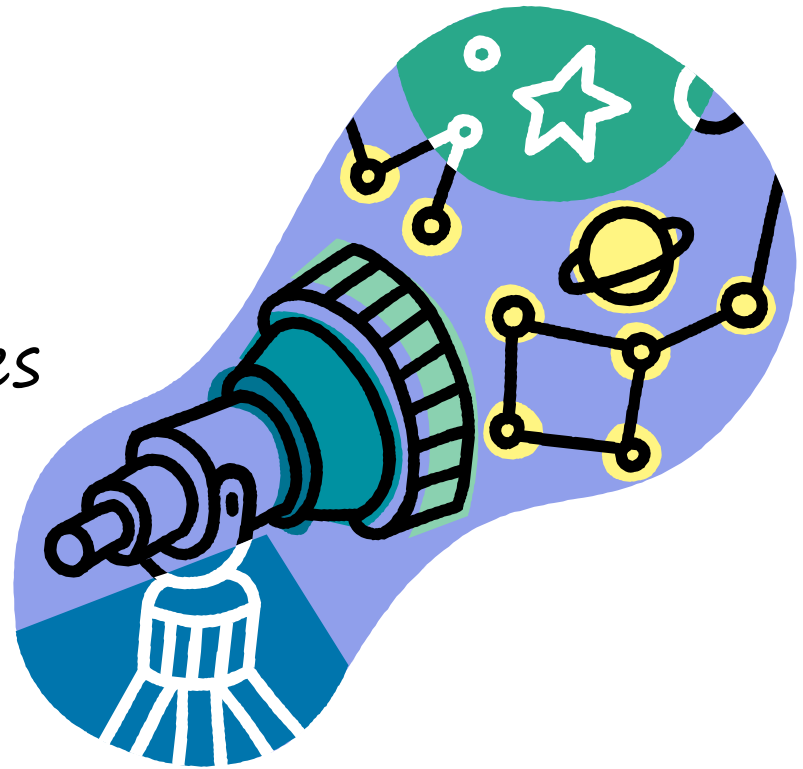
Self-management Skills:
