#### Notes:

- High schools must follow the same bell schedule so students and teachers can attend/teach classes on other campuses.
- When a teacher travels between a high school and middle school, the two principals should determine when/where it is not possible for the teacher to be in both places at the same time. They should arrange supervision for classes that will not be covered because the teacher has a responsibility on a different campus at the same time.
- High school and middle school students will travel to the high school where the course is given to take exams. Laurence Binder will communicate with transportation regarding the exam schedule.
- Senior exams will be May 28, 29, and June 1 and 2, and grade 9-11 exams will be May 29 and June 1-3. Two exams, approximately two hours in length, will be scheduled for each day.
- Attendance will be checked each day at the end of the first test and at the beginning of the second test (approximately 9:30 a.m.). All grade levels must be checked on June 1, 2, and 3, including seniors who are in attendance.
- Breakfast will be served each day, May 25-29. Friday, May 29 will be the last day lunch is served.
- On early release days, June 1, 2, and 3, students who have their own transportation or rides may leave at 11:30 a.m. Students who ride the bus will be transported at 1:00 p.m. Schools must supervise students during the 11:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. waiting period.
- Middle school shuttles will run through Friday, May 29. After that date, students will be transported on their exam day. *Example:* If a middle school student takes a 1<sup>st</sup>-period class at high school, he will be transported on Monday, June 1, for the 1<sup>st</sup>-period exam (7:25 a.m. – 9:30 a.m.).
- NAC, Carlton, and PLATO (Ranch and Windfern High School) shuttles will run as regularly scheduled until the last day of school, Wednesday, June 3, 2009.
