

Final Presentation Development

In-Class Instructions:

1. Get in your Final Report groups (40mins)
 - a) Develop three presentations (of about 5 slides each) of your final report's Context, Analysis and Recommendations for Instituting LCA sections.
 - b) Assign a group member to each Final Presentation group (ie. Context, Analysis and Recommendations).
2. Get in your Final Presentation groups (60mins)
 - a) Make note of who is in your Final Presentation group.
 - b) Each group member present their Final Report group's slides for this section (ie. don't need to present all slides developed, just those relevant to that section).
 - c) Develop your sections slides as a group. Aim to make your presentation 10minutes long.
 - d) Assign student(s) to present your section's slides.
3. Present Sections to class and get feedback.
4. Class vote on Presentation Coordinator – this student coordinates bringing slides into final draft and does Introduction/What is LCA and Conclusion of presentation.
5. Get in your Final Presentation groups
 - a) Catch up on feedback
 - b) Assign tasks for developing slides
 - c) Confirm who is the primary point of contact with the Presentation Coordinator.
6. Check in with Presentation Coordinator on point of contact and when they want the slides.
