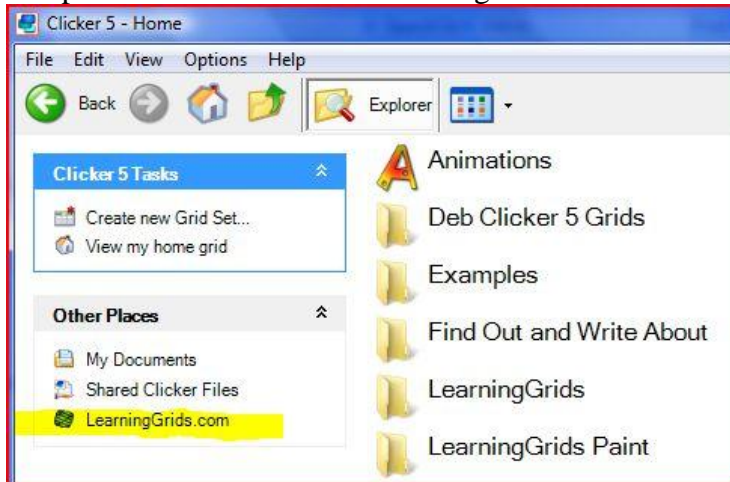

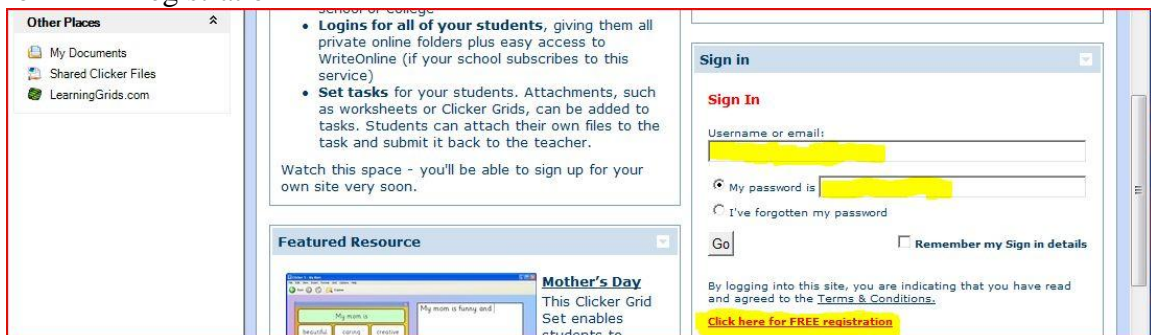
1. Open Clicker 5 ó click on LearningGrids.com



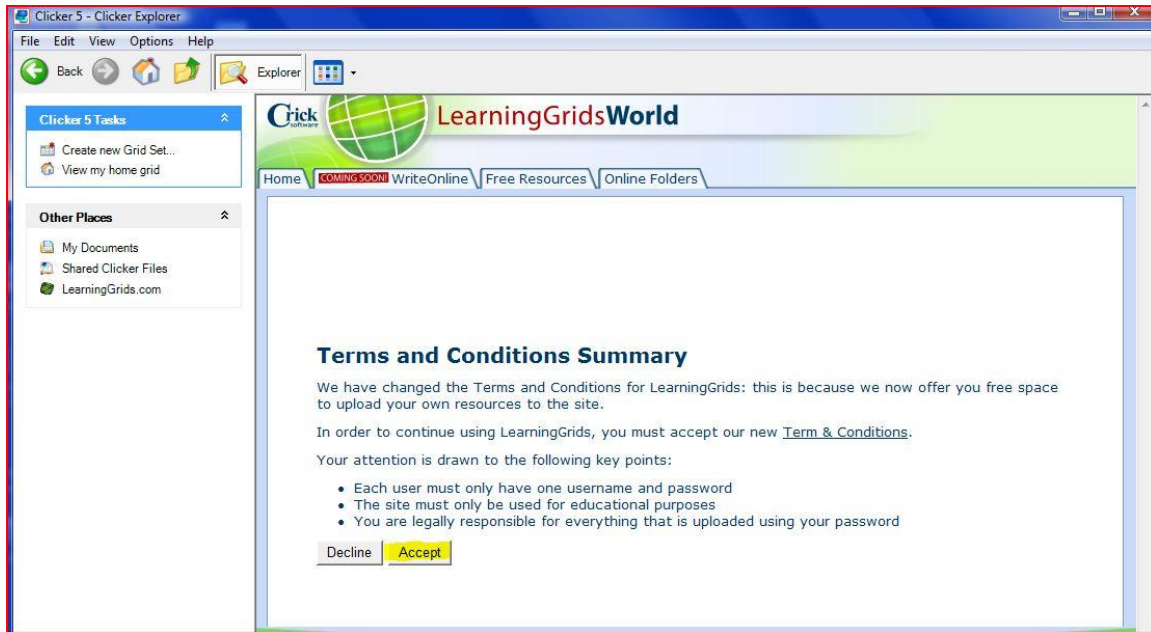
2. Click the Sign In link in the upper right hand corner of the screen



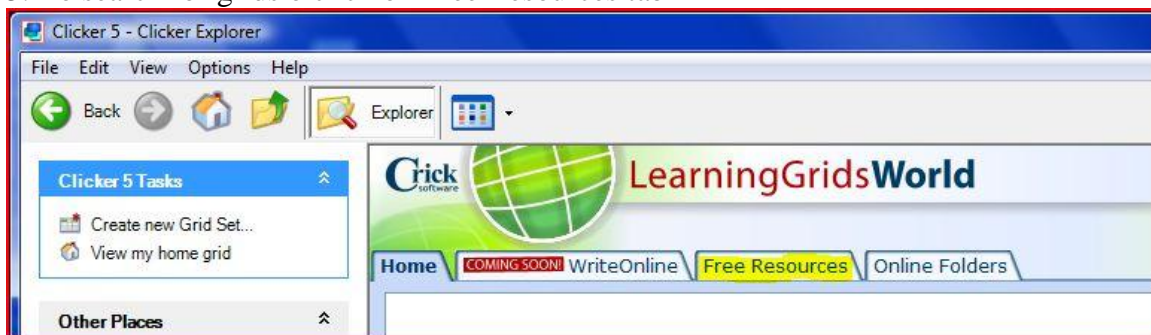
3. Or scroll down the page and Sign In ó if you aren't a member, click on the Click here for FREE registration



4. Click on the Accept button



5. To search for grids 6 click on Free Resources tab



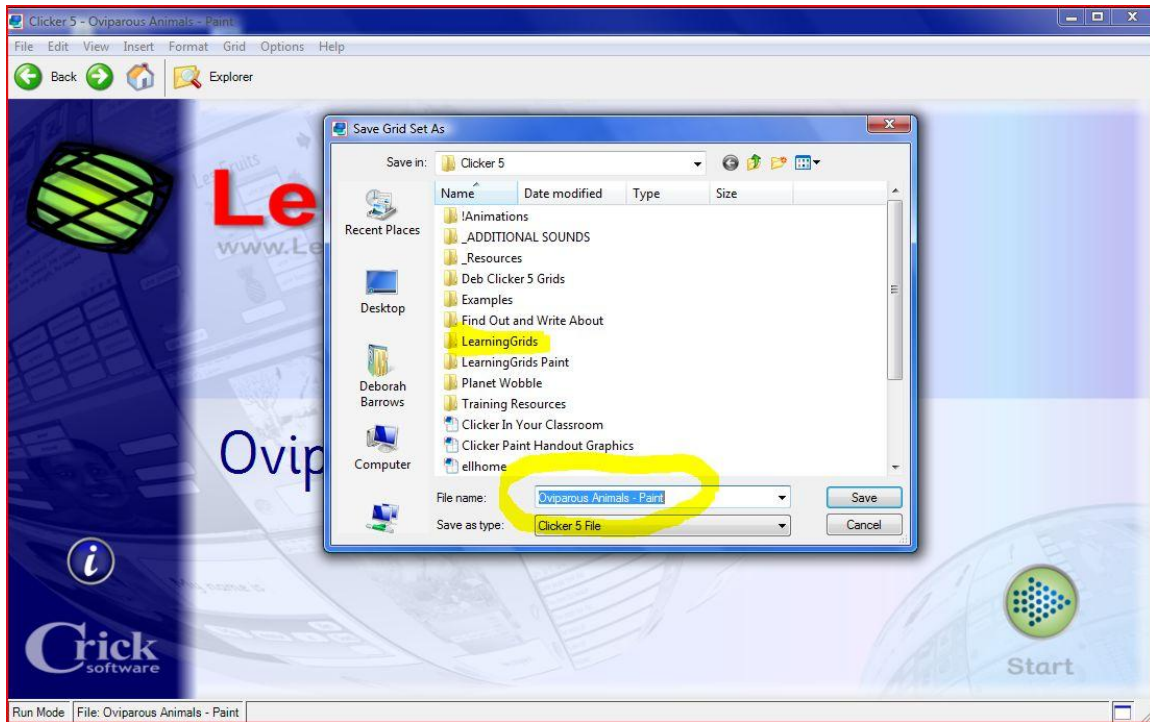
6. To search for grids either type the search words in the Search text box or click on a Categories. New grids are listed on this page and are updated every two weeks.



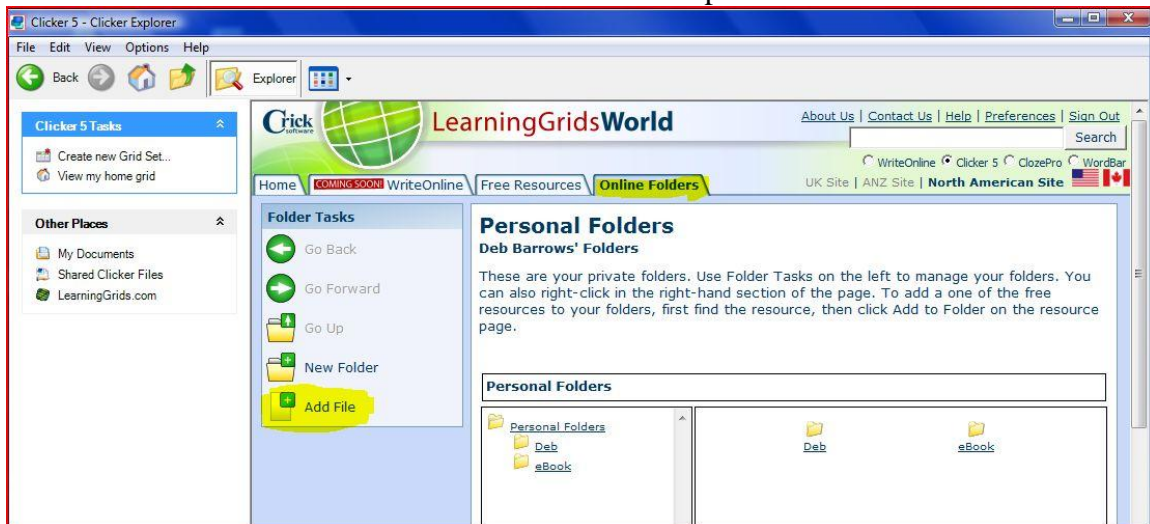
7. Click on the name of a grid and you'll see a description of the grid set and an example of a page in the grid set. Click Run Now and the grid will load into your computer. You can save it or modify and save with a new name. Or you can add the grid to a folder in your account.



8. Once a grid is loaded on your computer you can save it to your computer: File or Save Grid Set as or I save my LearningGrids grids into the LearningGrids folder



9. You can save and upload grids to your account. Click on the Online Folders tab and click on Add File ó follow the onscreen directions to upload a file.



10. You will see a new tab: WriteOnline ó this is a new online word processor with writing support for students in grades 3-12. Take the Tour and learn all about this new fantastic program: WriteOnline (this will be switch accessible too!)
