- **Complete**
 - A cover page / title page with student name, class and subject name on the folder
 - Divider (something to separate the different sections)
 - Course Outline (Yearly overview)
 - Assessment (Assessment schedule, MYP Assessment Criteria, Assessment Notification, Assessment paper, Assessment result, etc.)
 - Teaching material, handouts, including the following topics:
 - Decimals
 - Fractions
 - Problem solving strategies
 - Basic Algebra (including: growing patterns)
 - Percentages
 - Measurement
 - Notes, class-work and homework (Mathematics Journal)
- **Neat**
 - No loose pages that fall out of the folder
- **Organised**
 - Different sections are clearly separated
