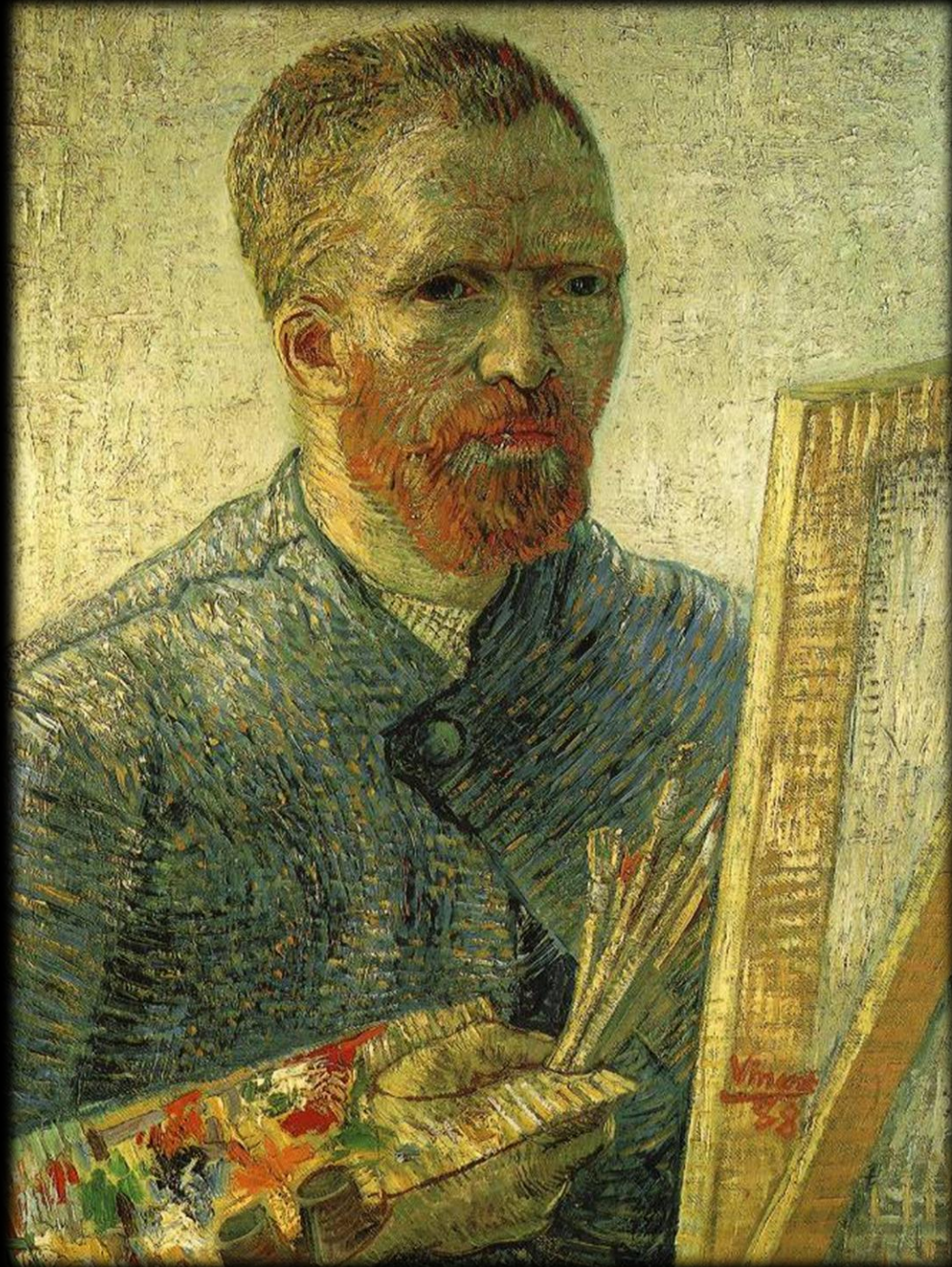

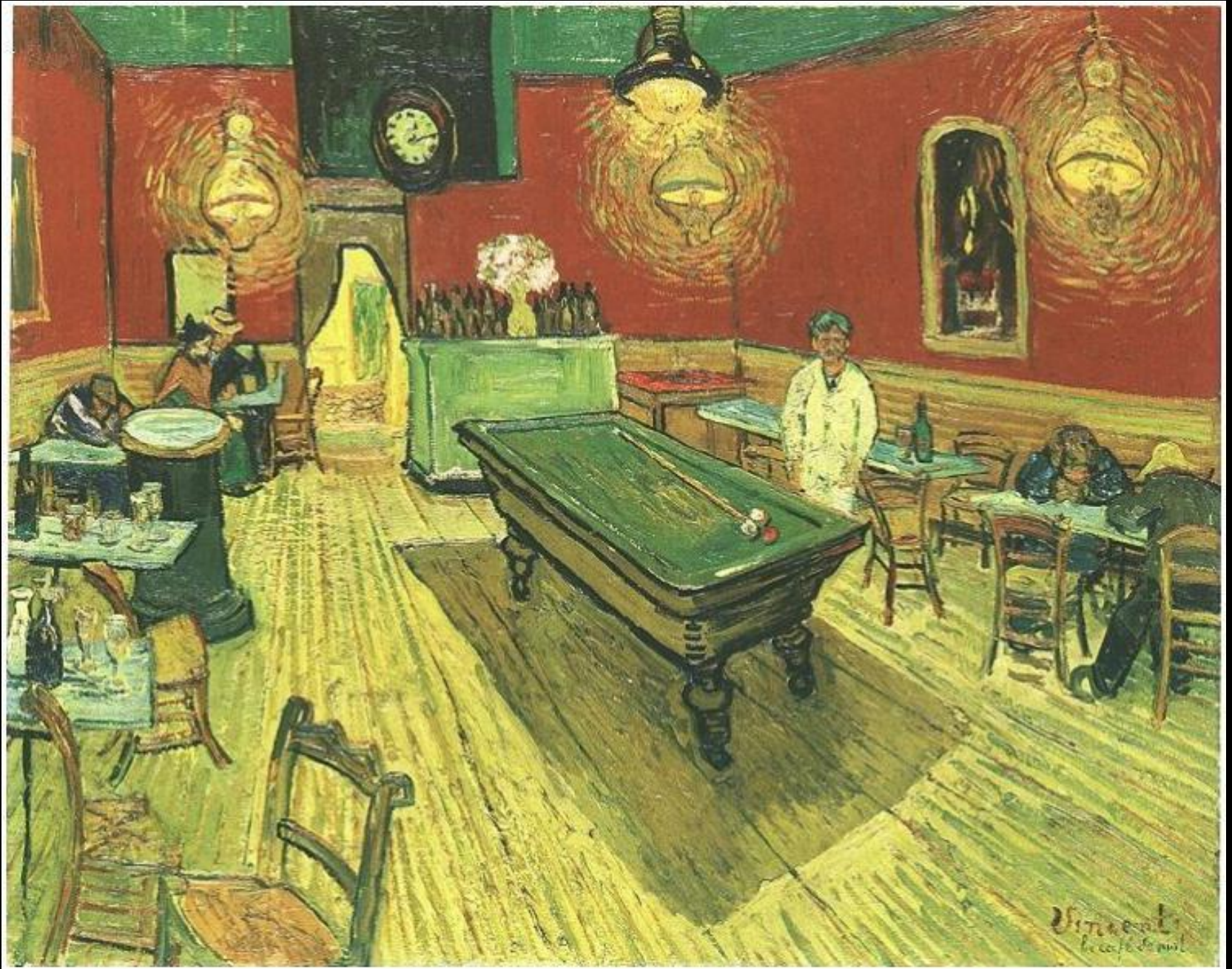

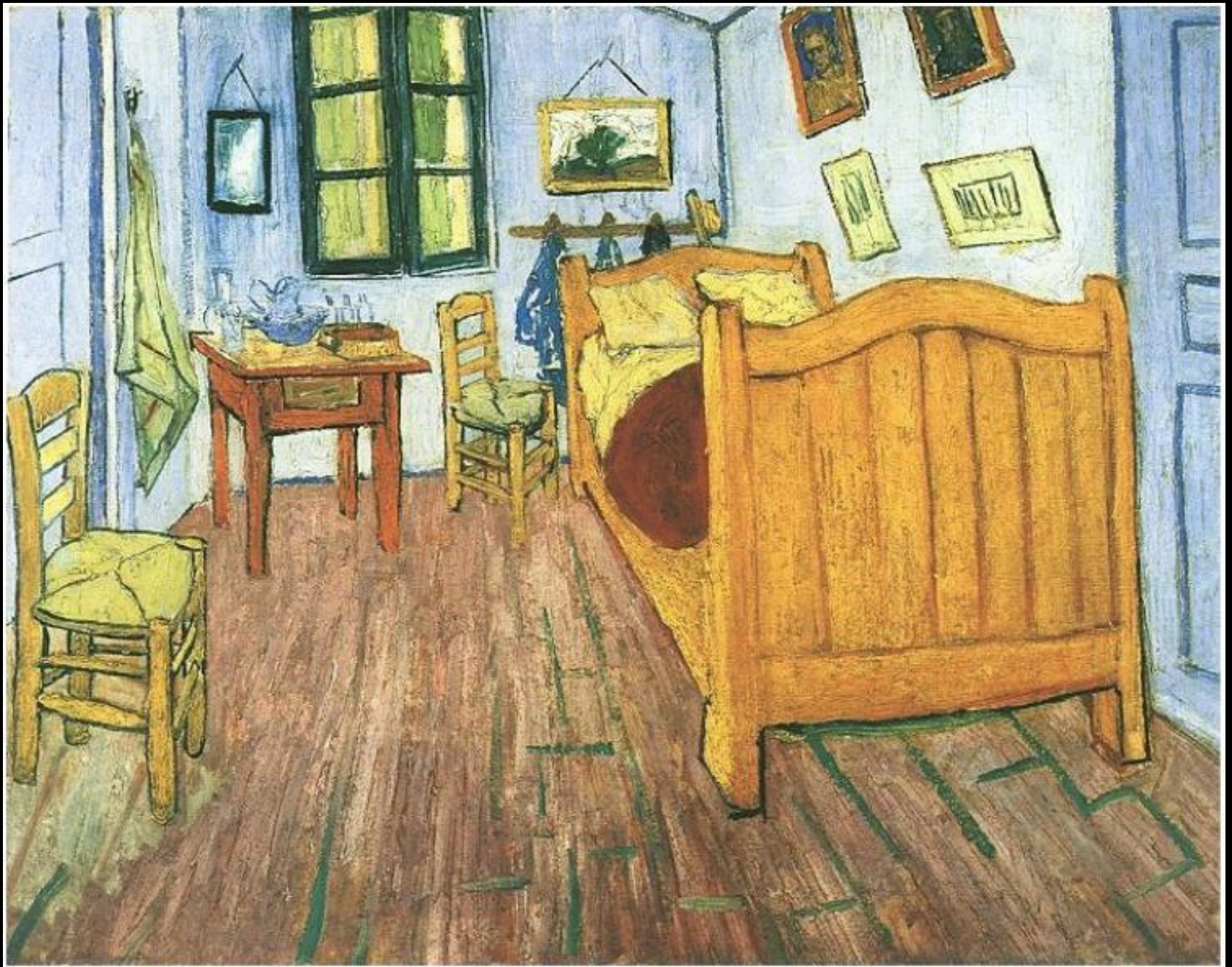

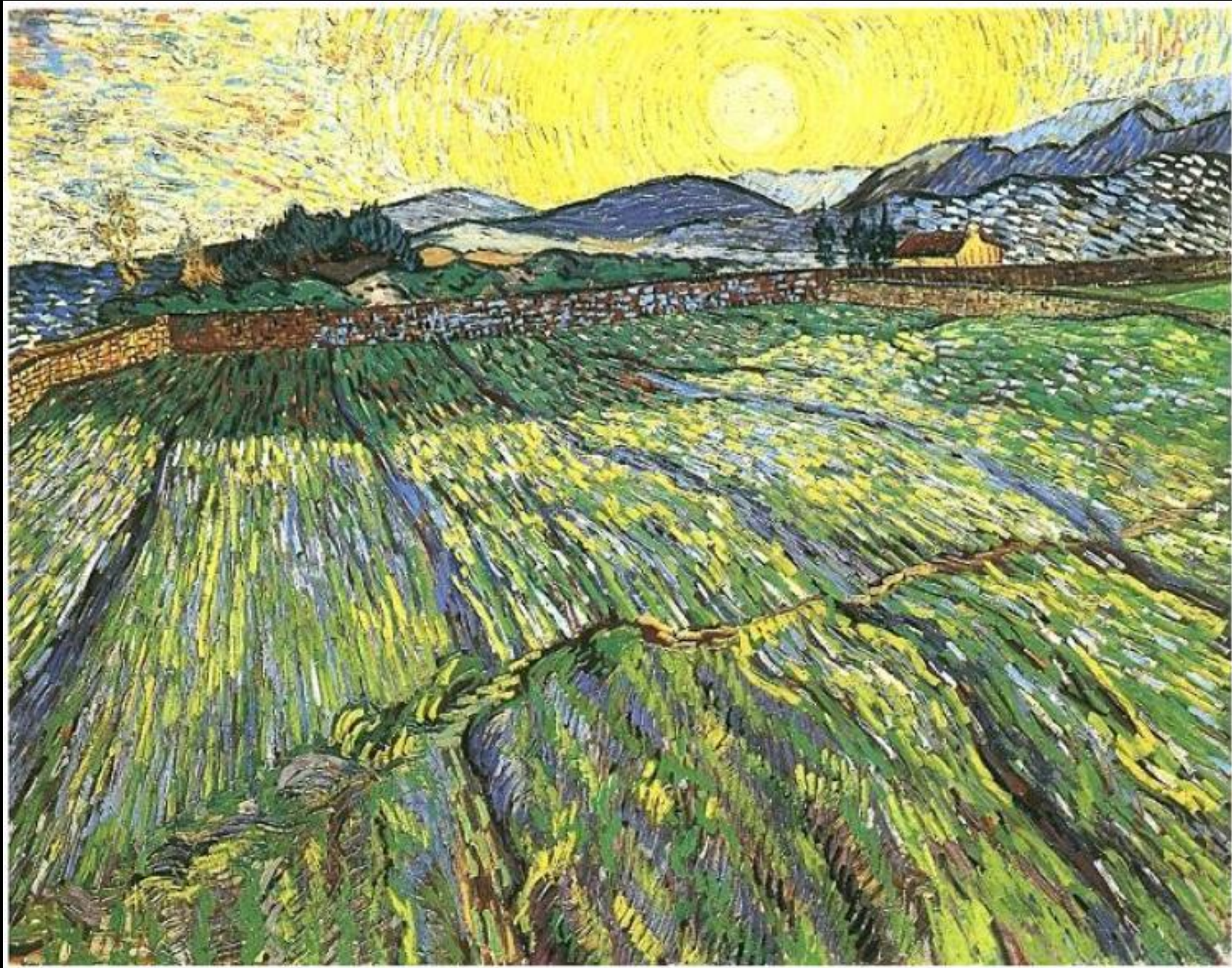

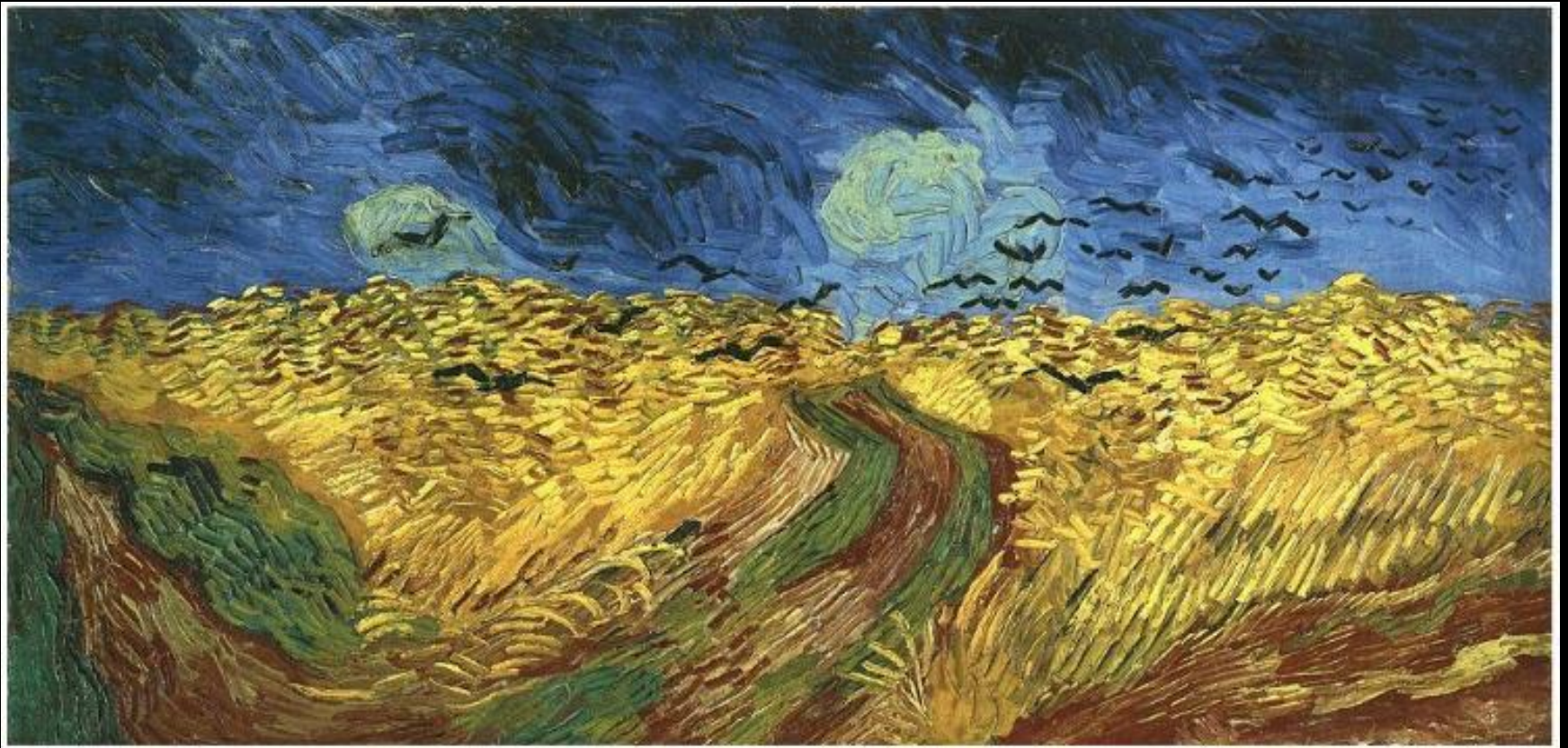

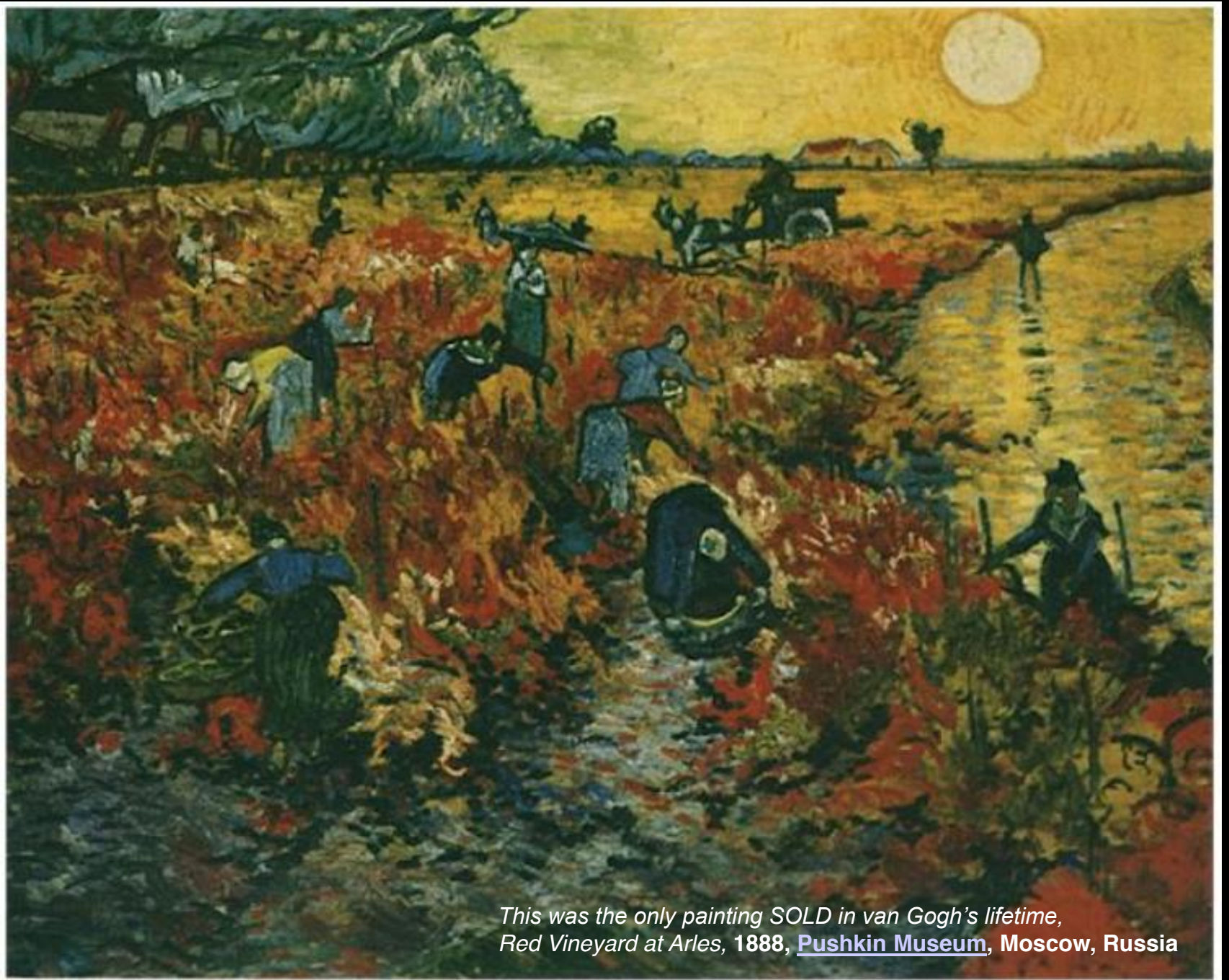


Wheat Field with Crows, Oil on Canvas, July, 1890, [Van Gogh Museum](#), Amsterdam,


After Vincent van Gogh's death at the age of 37, his family brought his paintings to the attention of the world, making him famous. In the ten short years he was an artist, he created more than 800 paintings and drawings. These are worth millions of dollars today.



A Pair of Shoes is an oil on canvas (14-3/4 x 17-3/4 inches) that is housed in the Van Gogh Museum in Amsterdam.
