

Base Word Ending -ing  
One – One – One Test

Directions:

1. Stomp the word. If it has ONE syllable, put an 'X' in the first box.
2. Color the vowel(s) in the word **YELLOW**. If it's spelled with one letter and is a short vowel, put an 'X' in the second box.
3. Color the consonant(s) at the end of the word **RED**. If there is only one consonant at the end of the word, put an 'X' in the third box.
4. In the final box in the row, if the word gets an 'X' in all three boxes, double the final consonant and spell the new word by adding -ing.
5. If you don't have three 'X's, do not double the last letter.

The first one is done for you:
