

## ENDING /CH/ WORD SORT

1. Read all the words to the students and segment all the sounds.
2. Underline the letter(s) that make the sound right before the ending /ch/. For example: couch, bench, fetch
3. Cut the words apart.
4. Sort the words into two piles: words with short vowel sounds and long vowel sounds
5. Sort words by how the /ch/ sound is spelled in the word: ch and tch
6. When is the final /ch/ spelled “tch?” (When the sound right before the /ch/ is a short vowel) When is the final /ch/ spelled “ch?” (When the sound right before the /ch/ is a long vowel or consonant sound)
