

1-1-1 Rule  
LETRS Module 3

- 1 syllable
  - 1 short vowel
  - 1 consonant (at the end)
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= Double the final consonant before adding suffixes that begin with a vowel

When using words to teach the rule:

- Review short and long vowel sounds with motions
- Stomp all words to find how many syllables
- Segment sounds in words to find how many graphemes (this will help students determine how many letters are used to spell the vowel sound)
- Use a chart similar to the one attached to study the words and apply the rule when appropriate
- Apply this rule to other suffixes that begin with vowels: ing, ed, er, est, ist, etc...
