1. Read all the words.
2. Underline the letter(s) after the “c” or “k” in each word that makes the second sound in that word. For example: Kyle, cash, coat
3. Cut the words apart.
4. Sort the words into “things and actions.” (2 piles)
5. Sort words by the spelling of /k/. (2 piles)
6. Look at the second letter in each word. If that letter is “a, o, or u,” how do we spell beginning /k/? (with a “c”) If that letter is “e, i, or y,” how do we spell beginning /k/? (with a “k”)
