

ENDING “Y” WORD SORT

1. Read all the words to the students and segment all the sounds.
2. Use duck lips to count how many syllables in each word.
3. Cut the words apart.
4. Sort the words into two piles: words with double letters and words without.
5. Sort words by the ending sound in each word: “long i” and “long e”
6. When is “y” pronounced like “long i?” (one syllable word) When is “y” pronounced like “long e?” (two syllable word)
