Classification of Death and Injury Resulting from Terrorism in ICD-9-CM

- First time emergency procedures to implement new diagnosis codes used since creation of HIV codes in 1986
- Consultation with:
 - Dept. of Justice's Bureau of Justice Statistics
 - FBI
 - Heads of the WHO Collaborating Centers for the Family of International Classifications
 - National Association of Medical Examiners

- FBI definition of terrorism used
- Structure similar to Operations of War in ICD-10

- ICD-9-CM codes become effective Oct. 1, 2002

- **Section 2 - Selection of Principal Diagnosis for Inpatient, Short-term, Acute Care Hospitals Records**
- **Section 3 - Reporting Additional Diagnoses**
- **Sections 4 - Diagnostic Coding and Reporting Guidelines for Outpatient Services**

Revision of Format for the Official Coding and Reporting Guidelines for ICD-9-CM

- No content changes to guidelines
- Facilitate consistent use of guidelines
 - Incorporate conventions of ICD into guidelines
 - Follows the format of ICD-9-CM
 - Identifies general guidelines from those specific to the inpatient setting only
- Facilitate future expansion of guidelines
