##### Code Changes In Brief

- Codes added for new PCS root operation *Supplement*, and to match ICD-9-CM 2009 new codes
- Codes deleted principally to streamline body part specificity as applied to certain general devices (e.g., radioactive element)
- Individual code values revised or deleted for clarity and ease of use

- Most new values added in 2009 are parallel with new I-9 codes

# ICD-10-PCS 2010 Update Plans

- Add new codes
  - in parallel with ICD-9-CM changes
  - in response to public requests to CMS
- Delete codes or change code descriptions
  - ongoing improvements from internal review and public feedback to CMS
- Ongoing enhancements to code set and draft guidelines
  - in response to public requests to CMS
  - as needed for clarity and ease of use
