

Your non-fiction reading assignment will be due April 12th/April 13th.

However, I would like to make sure you are on track to finish reading and will still have time to do the significant writing portion of the assignment. **Due next class:**

- ∴ **Select 2 quotations from different places in your book that represent 2 different arguments.** If you have not finished reading yet, you should still select these quotations from places in the book that are decently far apart.
- ∴ Then, **create a piece of visual rhetoric for each quotation** (you will have 2 visuals in total to turn in). Use facts and evidence from your non-fiction work, and incorporate strategies to communicate the author's argument effectively.
- ∴ *A few restrictions:*
 - 8.5" x 8.5"
 - black and white only
 - no words
 - flat
- ∴ Otherwise, you are free to what you want to convey the arguments. Some ideas (but do not limit yourself to these): advertisement, photograph, product design, illustration, architecture plan, collage, or comic.
- ∴ **Please put on the back:** name, date, title of your book or name of your columnist, and your quotation.
