Important Points:

1. Sign in with “School GOOGLE account. Make sure you click the school account e-mail.
2. Fill out the information that is requested
3. ALWAYS “Save and Continue” or you will lose some information.

STEP 1: Career Exploration. Read the information and then Click **Career Clusters**.

Career Path:

1. Watch the short **Work Values Assessment** video (1 min, 14 sec)
2. Students are provided the Work Values Assessment worksheet so they can plan accordingly.
 - a. Each column only allows a total of four statements so this exercise will force you to *evenly divide all of the statements below* into the five columns. If you wish to change selections for any of the statements where you’ve already selected four, you must first deselect one of the original selections before you may your new selection.
 - b. If you are not satisfied with the results you may take it again.
 - c. If you are satisfied with your results, select **“Return to MAP”** and click on the one or two work value codes you scored the highest.
 - d. If you hover over the two values they will give you a short description.

Career Interest Inventory

1. Watch the short video (1 min, 39 sec)
2. Click on the **Career Interest Inventory**. A new window will open.
3. Click on **Start Assessment**-begin the assessment, click next and continue on for the next 3 pages.
4. Next will be a summary screen.
 - a. On the right of the screen are a list of the occupations that closely match your interest.
 - b. On the left top are the RIASEC (Realistic, Investigative, Artistic, Social, Enterprising, Conventional)
 - c. Hit Return to Map-
 - d. Highlight your top 2

Career Cluster Options:

1. Watch the short video (54 sec)
2. “V” is your values
3. “I” next to career cluster is your “interest.”
4. If there is a cluster with “I” and “V” you should give it special attention.
5. Hover over the cluster and click on the ONE cluster that interests you MOST.

6. What are your top 3 clusters?

Pathway:

1. Watch the short video (22 seconds)
2. Hover over each of the pathways listed.
3. Click on the **one pathway** that interests you the most.

Careers:

1. Watch the short video (55 seconds)
2. Faded out careers are not the best matches for you based on your work values.
3. Click on any career to see a very detailed description of that particular career. (Knowledge, skills, ability, personality, technology, education, job outlook, average salary, more research on this career).
 - a. Need additional help picking a career?
 - b. Watch the short video (1 min, 36 sec)
 - c. Click on **Skills Profiler**.
 - i. Scroll down to **Start with your skills**, then click on continue button.
 - ii. Click on skills you think you possess and then click on the continue button.
 - iii. Basic Skills: click on any of the box under each skill set that you feel you possess. (Skill Sets: Basic social, complex, technical, systems, resource management, desktop computer skills)
 - iv. Click continue
 - v. Skills Profiler: Rate your skill level in each area. If you need a reminder of what that skill represents, hover over the skill.
 - vi. May also click on Compare your skills to get a list of occupations. This is on the bottom of the page.
 - d. Click on **Return to Map** at the top.
 - i. Enter any notes in the box provided.
 - ii. **Click on Save and Continue.**

1. Watch the short video (1 min, 09 sec)
2. This is a sample schedule based on the career pathway you chose in Step 4.
3. Click **Return to Map**.

STEP 2: Course Planning: Your courses:

STEP 3: College and Career Readiness

Your readiness can be estimated using three factors:

1. High school course selection
2. Cumulative GPA
3. ACT Test Score

STEP 4: Options Beyond HS

1. Select an occupation within the career pathway you've already chosen in the Career Exploration Section. If you wish to change the option listed, return to the Career Exploration section and change your selection (s).
2. Select a major or training program to prepare you for that occupation.

 - a. Click on College Board online College Search
 - b. Click on Majors and Learning Environment
 - c. Explore Future Plans: Watch video (1 min, 13 sec)
