- Checking the daily schedule to set my day's agenda to squeeze in as much as I can.

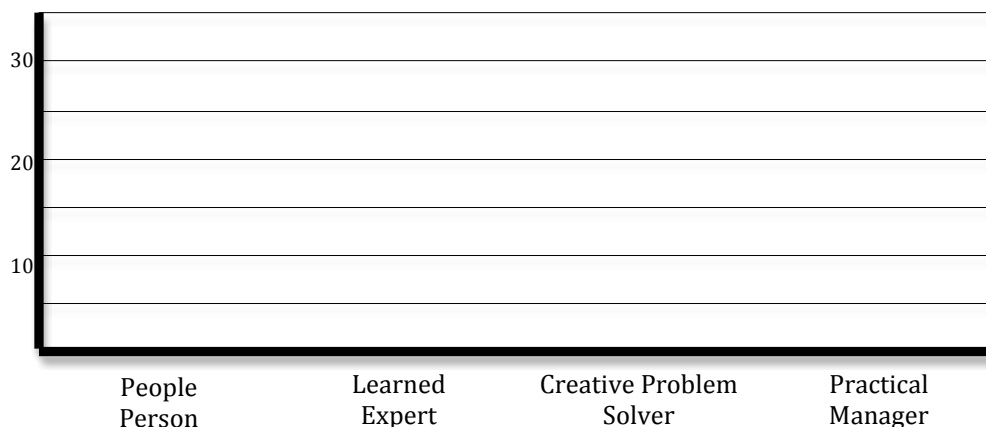
