

## **Job Summary Virginia View QUESTIONS :**

Answer all of the following questions with complete sentences. Once you choose the job you like, you can use the links on the right hand side of the page to find the answers to these questions. **If you see the words “SEE MORE”, or “More >>” click on it to show more information.**

**First: Either open your saved word document with your results, or open the webpage with the summary results. You will need to click on the career cluster with the highest number. In word you can hold the CTRL key and click the link to open it in a webpage. If you have a tie, pick whichever career cluster you like.**

**Next you will see a bunch of careers listed. Look through the list, and choose the career that you are the most interested in. If you do not see even one career you are interested in, go back and choose a different career cluster so you can see different jobs.**

**Pick a job you are interested in. You will be answering the questions below. Make sure you demonstrate content knowledge by being able to summarize what you are reading about your career.**

1. What is the Name of your job?
2. What is the description of your job?
3. What is the education level needed for your job? Make sure to write what the required level of education, the Related Work Experience, the On-Site or In-Plant Training, and the On-The-Job Training. Write about the values with the highest percent for each category.
4. What kind of tasks do you need to do for this job? Make sure to write about a few core tasks and supplemental tasks.
5. What kind of tools do you need for this job? Make sure to write about some of the tools, and the Technologies that are important to this job.
6. Are there any special requirements for the job? Make sure to write about what you have to do in order to get this job.
7. What different things do you have to have knowledge of for this job, and what are the descriptions of those things? Give summaries of the top 3.
8. What skills do you need for this job and what are their descriptions? Give summaries of the top 2.
9. What abilities do you need for this job and what are their descriptions? Give summaries of the top 2.
10. What sort of work activities are there for this job and what are their descriptions? Give summaries of the top 2.
11. What work styles do you need for this job and what are their descriptions? Give summaries of the top 2.
12. What work values do you need for this job and what are their descriptions? Give summaries of the top 2.
13. What work context can you expect for this job and what are their descriptions? Give summaries of the top 2.
14. What is the “Job Zone” needed for this job? Give a summary of the Overall Experience, Job Training, Examples, and Education needed for this job.
15. What are the earnings benefits for the state of Virginia, (or U.S. if VA wasn’t available)? Make sure to include the

values for Entry Level, Average, and Experienced. Do not copy the table, put this in a sentence.

16. What are the employment projections for your job for the state of Virginia (or the U.S. if VA wasn't available)? For the **UNITED STATES** - Make sure to say what the employment numbers are for the most current (on the website it is 2012), and what the projected values will be in the future (2022), and say what the percentage of change is (and if it is a positive change or negative change). Do not copy the table, put this in a sentence.
17. What are some related occupations to the job you chose? Also, what are some careers that relate in the pathway you chose – and what pathway is your job under?
18. Write a summary about one of the videos you could view for your job. The summary needs to be at least 5 sentences long. You can talk about exactly what you watched and what you found interesting about the job.
19. Is there any military training that would be beneficial for this job? If you can click on a job to learn more about it, also write a couple sentences about the information you find.
20. What are the proficiency ratings of this job? (Name a few that are very important and a few that are not important – remember the higher the rating, the more important that skill is for your job.)
21. What are some of the other Titles that your job is also called?
22. Find a related school to your job choice. To do this you will need to click on “**Find Related Schools**”, and then click on one of the schools that is displayed on the screen. You will then have new links on the right hand side of the screen in the grey that will give you information about your school. Make sure to have the answers to these questions in your answer – What is the highest degree offered, what is the tuition per year, what is the description of the school, what test do you need to take to enter, how many students attend that school? Also, write about other information you may find useful. Make sure you click on all of the categories – Admissions, Costs, Programs, Financial Aid, Enrollment, Student Services, and Athletics.
