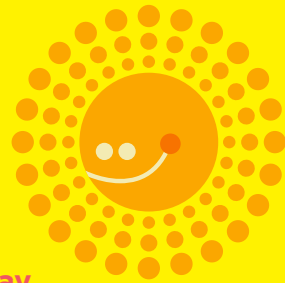

20 Read <i>Circle, Square, Moose</i> by Kelly Bingham or another book about shapes.	21 Get creative by coloring a picture today. Talk about the colors your child used.	22 Teach your child to recite "Humpty Dumpty."	23 It's the first day of fall. Talk about what will happen to the leaves this season.	24 Help your child to use his or her fingers to count to the number 9.	25 What day is this? Talk to your child about the days of the week.	26 Take a family field trip to the library.
27 Collect different types of leaves and make rubbings together.	28 Read for 15 minutes today as a family.	29 Using a recipe, have your child help you make dessert.	30 Talk about the favorite book you read this month. Read it again.			

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
