WHAT WAS THE DUBIN INQUIRY?

Called when Ben Johnson requested a thorough public inquiry as to all the circumstances surrounding his disqualification at the 1988 Seoul Olympics

- Started Jan. 11, 1989
- Ended Oct. 3, 1989
- 119 witnesses
- 14,817 pages of testimony
- Cost approximately \$4 million
