

How to make my snowman

1. Choose 9933cc (purple/pink) for the background.
2. Choose 009933 (green) and draw a 24 size line along the bottom of the page.
3. Put a 2 inch black circle shape with #6666ff (powder blue) as the outline with a black center. Center it at the bottom of the page.
4. Add another ball on top that is 5 cm diameter and overlapping the 2nd ball on top of the bottom ball about ½ way. Make the ball colored dark purple #09900cc for the inside of the circle and light purple #9966cc for the outline
5. Add a third ball on top of that. Make it 4 cm in diameter, overlapping it on top of the ball below it about ½ way. This ball is colored blue (#3366ff) in the center and outlined red (#ff000).
6. Add a fourth ball on top of that. Make it 3 cm in diameter, overlapping it the same as before. This ball is colored the same as the 3rd ball.
7. Add red (# 66000) bunny ears on top of the 4th ball (the head).
8. Use the same color as the bunny ears to add arms on the 3rd ball. The arms should be 2 cm long with three 1 cm fingers at the end of each arm. (Make the size of the lines a size 10 in thickness).
9. Add 10 snowflakes falling in the background behind the snowman. The snowflakes should be small (pencil eraser sized) white balls with red (#66000) vertical lines in them.
10. Use the same red color to draw 2 circle eyes and a mouth on the top ball of the snowman.
11. My snowman talks. Draw a speaking bubble coming out of his mouth to the right with a thin black line. Inside the bubble he says "Good morning sir." You can either free write his words or add a text box on top of the bubble to type his greeting.
