

Math Department – Missed Test (Assessment) Policy

Any student **unable to write a test or major assessment due to an absence for any reason** (including school related activities), during the school period in which the test or assessment is taking place, must write the missed test or assessment **after school** on a day scheduled by the math department. A student is required to write the missed test or assessment on the closest scheduled make-up test day after the absence. If the student **fails to appear** for the make-up test or assessment, he/she will receive **a mark of zero on that test or assessment**.

- The student must arrange for their own transportation home after the test.
- The student **must bring photo ID** with them to the make-up test.
- A student will have to **appear before administration** (vice-principal or principal) **if more than one make-up test day is used in a semester**.
