Directions: Read and complete each word problem below. Be sure and show ALL of your work.

Santa had to visit 10 houses on Snowy Lane. If he delivered 9 presents to each house, how many presents did he deliver?



$10 \text{ houses} \times 9 \text{ presents} =$
 90 presents

He delivered 90 presents.

Santa ate 2 cookies and drank one glass of milk at each house. How many total cookies would Santa have eaten after he visited 6 houses?



$2 \times 6 = 12 \text{ cookies}$
 $1 \times 6 = 6 \text{ glasses of milk}$

Santa ate 12 cookies and drank 6 glasses of milk after visiting 6 houses.

Santa has 9 reindeer and each reindeer has 4 legs. How many reindeer legs are there in all?



$9 \text{ reindeer} \times 4 \text{ legs} = 36 \text{ reindeer legs}$

There are 36 reindeer legs.

Each elf carried 7 presents to the sleigh. If 8 elves put presents in the sleigh so far, how many total presents are in the sleigh?



$7 \text{ presents} \times 8 \text{ elves} = 56 \text{ total presents}$

There are 56 presents in the sleigh.



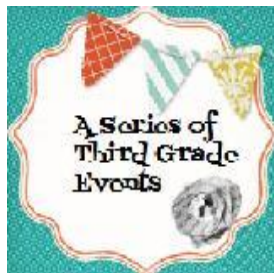
