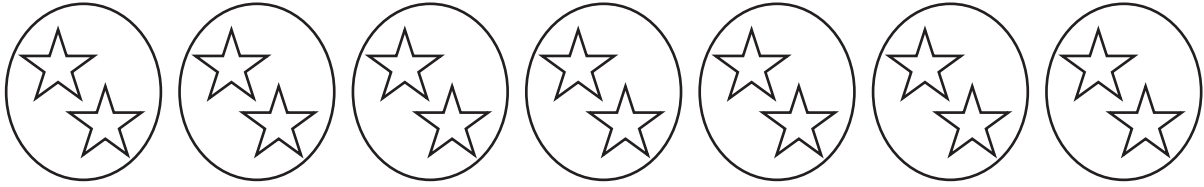


1. Which division problem matches the picture below?

- B $15 \times 5 = 75$
- C $15 \div 5 = 3$
- D $15 \div 3 = 5$
