School Library Paraprofessional Scholarship

The CSLA Southern Section recognizes the need for trained and qualified library paraprofessionals in Southern California and has established an educational **scholarship in the amount of \$500** for library paraprofessionals. The purpose of this scholarship is to assist school library paraprofessionals in completing a school library technician/paraprofessional certificate program **or** in obtaining a teaching credential with the ultimate goal of pursuing a Teacher Librarian Services Credential.

To apply:

- 1) The applicant must be working in a classified position in the library media field, either in a school, district, or County Office of Education.
- 2) The applicant must be enrolled in a two-year paraprofessional program with the goal of becoming a qualified library technician or in a teacher credential program with the ultimate goal of pursuing a Teacher Librarian Services Credential. Evidence of enrollment must be provided.
- 3) The applicant must be a resident of the area served by the CSLA Southern Section. Please refer to the following link for a map of CSLA Sections and Regions: http://www.csla.net/southern/region_map_large.html
- 4) The applicant must be a member of the California School Library Association or become a member upon receipt of a scholarship.
- 5) The applicant must provide three letters of recommendation. One letter of recommendation must be from a CSLA Southern Section member, and one must be from a professor of the school in which the applicant is enrolled. The third letter must be from a former or current supervisor.
