### ***TEACHER LIBRARIAN SCHOLARSHIP***

#### *IN HONOR OF GENE WHITE AND THE MARTHA DEAN CHILDREN*

#### **Purpose**

Recognizing that there is a need for professional teacher librarians, the California School Library Association, Southern Section, offers **scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each**. The purpose is to assist those persons seeking preparation leading toward a degree or credential which will qualify the individual to work as a professional in the library media field in a school setting. Complete only one application. Winners will be selected from the eligible applications received.

#### **Requirements for Scholarship Applicants**

- 1) The applicant must be enrolled in a professional teacher librarian (school library media teacher) credentialing program or a Master's Degree program in preparation to become a school teacher librarian. Evidence of enrollment must be provided (transcript, current semester grade report, letter of admission, letter from program director, or copy of school registration). Financial need is not a requirement.
- 2) The applicant must be a resident of the area served by the CSLA Southern Section. Please refer to the following link for the map of CSLA Sections and Regions: [http://www.csla.net/southern/region\\_map\\_large.html](http://www.csla.net/southern/region_map_large.html)
- 3) The applicant must be a member of the California School Library Association or become a member on receipt of a scholarship.
- 4) Previous winners of this scholarship and those who will complete their LMT program by the time the current scholarship is awarded are not eligible.
- 5) The applicant must provide three letters of recommendation, using the form provided in this application packet. One letter of recommendation must be from a CSLA member, and one must be from a professor in the credential program in which the applicant is enrolled. The third letter may be from a former or current supervisor or a fellow teacher.
