

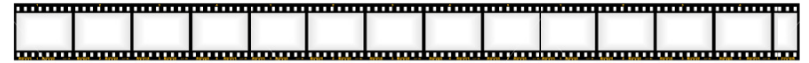

Background:

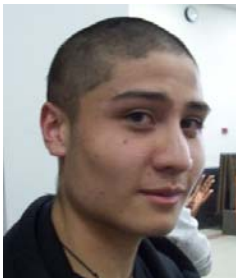

CHINESE

Background:




Background:

HEBREW

Background:

Hebrew theatre is young: only three-quarters of a century separate the first professional Hebrew production in 1918 and current theater events in Tel Aviv, Israel's theater capital. The almost total lack of theater traditions demonstrates a particularly strong link between Israeli reality and universal theatricality. Whereas any theater tradition may have similar claims to such socio-artistic characteristics, the rapid development of Hebrew theater is peculiarly linked with the secularization of the Jewish people and the revival of the Hebrew language in the last 100 years.

Summary:

We open the Hebrew portion of Dinner Theater just as Aladdin awakens outside the Cave of Wonders, where he finds that sneaky Abu has stolen a lamp. To Aladdin's surprise, as he rubs the lamp, a genie appears. The genie has the capability to grant Aladdin any three wishes he desires.

Undoing this wish wouldn't be a problem if the lamp hadn't been stolen ... so until then Aladdin is stuck in "a whole new world"... under the sea! Will Aladdin ever retrieve his lamp and return to normal, or will he be stuck as a mermaid princess forever?
