- Fundraiser Report –

- Swiss Steak dinner was reviewed. Only sold 147 Adult and 9 child portions. We need to stress to the students to encourage ticket "sales"/attendance. They get monies allocated for those. Thanks to Ruth Fedenets for extra effort to sell leftovers the next day. That increased the profit from \$579.02 to \$720.02. We also had \$131.50 collected in tips. Karen Bean has the information to transfer into student accounts. It was noted that we cannot permit "extra" students to come in and work unannounced. It reduces the amount from those that signed up.
- The Sr. High Chorus event "Mixed Up Music" – per request of Mr. Cameron the Music Boosters sold coffee and the chorus parents and others donated desserts. The proceeds have all gone into the Drama account. Thank you to everyone who supplied desserts and/or worked.
- The Marching Band proposed 2011 Disney Trip commitment papers have been set out and are due back in by Dec. 22nd. There will be an informational parent meeting on Weds. Dec. 15th at 6 PM prior to the Christmas concert.
- Renee Watson is following up on any marching band shorts not turned in yet and will update the list to Mr. Cameron. He will have the school hold any report cards for those students. She has been trying to finalize getting uniforms ready for the dry cleaners but we needed to remind students to get all personal items out of their uniform pockets and garment bags. She reports that quite a number of the berets will need the lining sewn again.
- We still have 7 yard signs available for sale (\$20 each) and 8 of the ballcaps with CV Music logo (\$10 each). From the latest shirt order we also have 5 ballcaps with a logo of just "CV" - these are \$12 due to the smaller quantity ordered. Let Dot know if you are interested in any of these items.
- A very positive and open idea meeting was held with Mr. Burns, Mr. Maskrey, Matt Rendulic and Mr. C on Friday, Dec. 3rd.
