### ***Entry Fees:***

One tournament = \$30  
Both tournaments = \$40

### ***Admission:***

Adults: \$8 per day or \$15 for  
an all-event pass.  
Students: \$6 per day or \$10 for  
an all-event pass.

### ***Awards:***

**Medals** to 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers in  
all divisions and styles.

**Floor Passes:** are available at the  
gate **only** to certified USA Wrestling  
Coaches that hold a 2009 USA  
Coaches' card **and** certification  
credentials. 1 coach's hospitality  
for every 10 kids registered.

## ***Tourn. Requirements***

All athletes **must** possess a  
current USA Wrestling card.  
Cards must be purchased online  
prior to the tournament.

All athletes **must** possess both a  
predominately red singlet and a  
predominately blue singlet (or 2  
piece) or a reversible red and blue  
singlet. Such uniforms will be  
available for purchase at the site.

Headgear is **mandatory** for all  
divisions schoolboy and below  
and encouraged for all others.

## ***Team Texas Info***

This tournament serves as the  
Team Texas qualifier for the  
Cadet/Junior men and the Junior  
Women. The top three finishers  
for boys & girls at each weight  
class become eligible to  
participate with Team Texas at  
National competitions this  
summer. Those who qualify  
should be prepared to fill out bio.  
Sheets, releases, and other  
required materials and post a  
non-refundable deposit **before**  
they leave the State Tournament.

## **2008 Texas USA Wrestling State Tournament Weigh-in Procedures and Weigh-in Sites**

All Greco and Women's freestyle participants shall weigh-in at a regional weigh-in site on Thursday, May 21<sup>st</sup> between 6:30 and 8:30 PM. This weigh-in shall also count as the weigh-in for freestyle, provided that the athlete completes the Greco tournament in good faith.

Male wrestlers competing in the freestyle tournament ONLY, shall weigh-in at Cy Woods High School on Friday, May 22<sup>nd</sup> between 6:00 and 9:00 PM.

Because this is a qualifying tournament, there will be no double entries permitted.

All athletes shall compete in the appropriate age division as set forth by USA Wrestling.

A Greco wrestler may elect to wrestle up one weight class for freestyle, but must re-weigh on Friday night at Arlington Bowie in order to do so. Under no circumstances shall a wrestler compete at a lower weight class in freestyle than he did in Greco.

Please bring proof of age and your USA card to the weigh-in. Cards may be purchased at the weigh-in site.

Please bring cash. The entry fee is \$30 for one tournament, or \$40 for both tournaments due at weigh-in.

### **Weigh-in Procedure:**

Once a competitor presents himself for weigh-in, he shall immediately get on the scale wearing his competition singlet or two-piece. In the event that he fails to make the weight at which he wishes to compete, he may immediately challenge the scale twice to allow for the possibility of mechanical inconsistency. **Or**, if multiple scales are present, he may immediately step on each available scale one time in the attempt to make the weight. At that point, his weigh-in is over. If he has not made the weight, he will be moved into the weight class for which he has qualified.

Weigh-in administrators are encouraged to make check scales available outside the weigh-in area for a 30 minute period preceding the start of the weigh-in. Athletes are encouraged to use the check scale before presenting themselves for the weigh-in. You simply cannot present yourself to the official scale, be overweight, then leave the weigh-in area to cut weight and try again before the scales close!

There are to be no vinyl or plastic suits, trash bags, or any other artificial means of dehydration used anywhere on or around (including the parking lot) the weigh-in site.
