A path following along the streets



- The Cycling path is about 1200 km long.
- There are about 50.000 bike stands.
- The traffic volume was in 2010 about 15%, now it has increased by approx. 2 %.
- Munich calls themselves "Bicycle Munich".
- You have pavements and cycle ways to cycle in Munich and around.
- You can cycle in the Alps (1 hour away) and you have great nice lakes around Munich area.

It is easy to buy and repair bikes because in nearly every street there is a bicycle shop.



You get a ticket from the police if:

- You bike the wrong direction
- You bike with headphones
- You don't have a light on in the night



The people who live around the school can cycle to school, using the cycle ways.



About 100 students bike to school, the rest by metro or bus, and most of the students don't wear a helmet.
