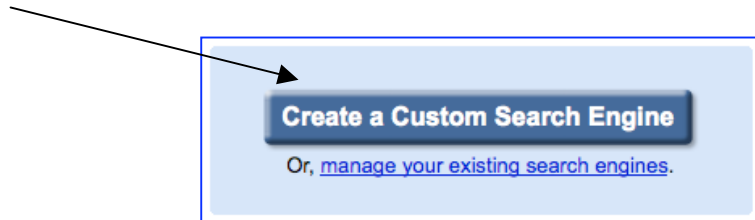


Introduction to Google Search

How to create a Custom Search Engine for your classroom:

1. <http://www.google.com/coop/cse/>
2. Click on Create.



3. Enter the Basic Information.

Basic information

Give your search engine a name and provide a brief description.

Search engine name:
for example, Real Climate Search Engine

Search engine description:
for example, Climate Science from Climate Scientists

4. Decide how you want to set up your search.





5. If you selected either of the first two options on #4, enter the websites from which you would like your search to come.





6. Select Standard Edition.




