
To get to Reading:

Reading. (telephone - 65202) (approx. £10.50 bed & breakfast, single)

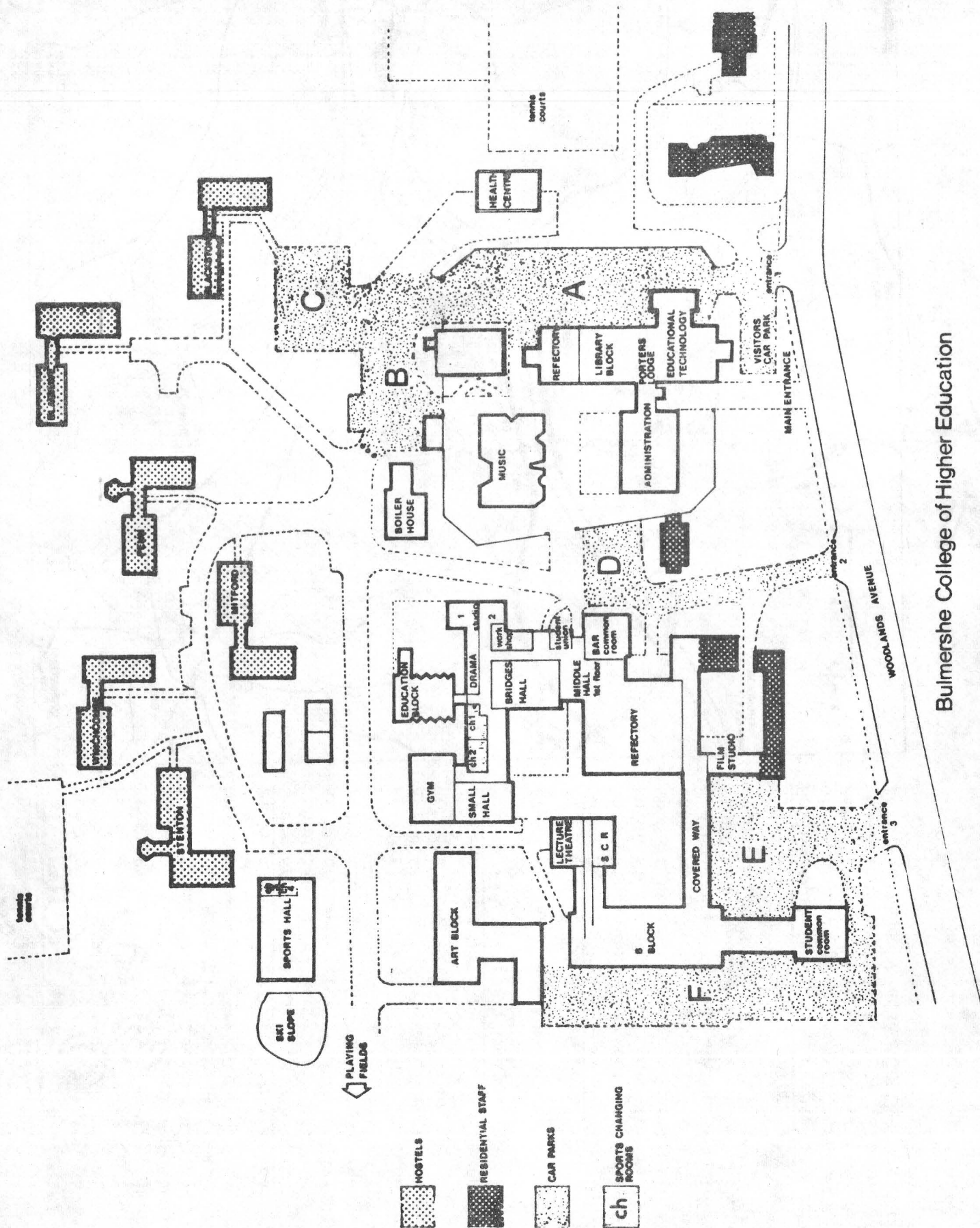
Similar to Elmhurst, about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles from College.
