At the COMAL 80 Seminar Copenhagen February 28 - March 1 it was decided to create two working groups of COMAL 80, a COMAL 80 Standardization Group, and a COMAL 80 Development Group.

The COMAL 80 Standardization Group

The COMAL 80 Standardization Group is responsible for the stabilization and the standardization of COMAL 80.

Basically the Standardization Group consists of Manufacturers / Developers responsible for the development and the marketing of their individual COMAL 80 Systems / Compilers. In addition the chairman of the COMAL 80 Development Group is appointed member of the COMAL 80 Standardization Group.

The Standardization Group is headed by a chairman to be elected by the group. Subject for election are members of the Standardization Group and members of the Development Group. If the chairman elected is not member of the Standardization Group, the chairman is considered appointed member of the COMAL 80 Standardization Group.

The Standardization Group may invite potential Manufacturers / Developers of COMAL80 Systems / Computers to join its meetings as observers.

The Standardization Group may decide to recognize new Manufacturers / Developers of COMAL80 and to offer such Manufacturers / Developers membership of the Standardization Group.

If a Manufacturer / Developer of COMAL80 is no longer marketing such product the Standardization Group may decide to exempt such Manufacturer / Developer from membership of the Standardization Group.

Individual members of the COMAL80 Development Group may attend meetings of the Standardization Group as observers.

Each Manufacturer / Developer of COMAL80 being member of the Standardization Group appoints one staff member as their representative. Such representative has one vote. The representative may ~~appoint~~ ~~substitute~~ for each meeting & appoint a substitute.

Each appointed member has one vote.

Observers have no votes.

Decisions to change the present bylaws of the Standardization Group and to ~~expand~~ ~~the~~ include new Manufacturers / Developers as members of the Standardization Group $\frac{4}{5}$ have to be ~~supported~~ supported by ~~the~~ of the existing members (rounded up) and ~~have to be~~ by all members present at the meeting. Such proposals ~~are~~ to be forwarded to the members no later than two months in advance of a meeting.

Other decisions made by the standardization Group are to be supported by a simple majority of the existing members ~~and~~ and by ~~the~~ $\frac{4}{5}$ of all members present at a meeting (rounded up). Such proposals ~~are~~ to be forwarded to the members no later than one month in advance of a meeting, or they have to be announced one month in advance and to be forwarded to the Concrete Development Group.

~~At meetings~~ ~~may~~ ~~decide~~ ~~the~~ Matters raised for a Standardization Group meeting may at the meeting be decided to be agreed upon by a letter ballot. In that case ~~all members~~ at such letter ballot all members are to be regarded present.

The COMAL80 Development Group

The COMAL80 Development Group is to serve as a Technical Committee for the Standardization Group. The group is responsible for providing clarifications to COMAL80. The group is responsible also for experimenting with new language elements to meet the requirements of existing or new markets. Clarifications and proposals for new language elements are to be forwarded to the COMAL80 Standardization Group for final approval.

The Development Group consists of COMAL80 experts. Members of the COMAL80 standardization Group are appointed members of the Development Group.

The Development Group is headed by a chairman to be nominated by the group and elected by the Standardization Group.

The Development Group may decide to recognize COMAL80 experts and to offer such experts membership of the Development Group.

Each member of the Development Group has one vote. Decisions made by the Development Group are to be supported by $\frac{2}{3}$ of all members present at a meeting (rounded up). Such proposals are to be forwarded to the members no later than one month in advance of a meeting.

Matters raised for a Development Group meeting may at the meeting be decided to be acted upon by a letter ballot. In that case at such letter ballot all members are to be regarded present.
