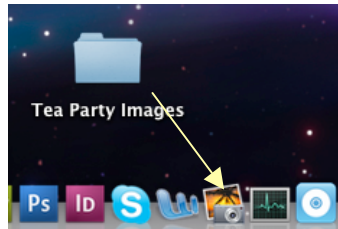


Digital Documentaries | iMovie 09

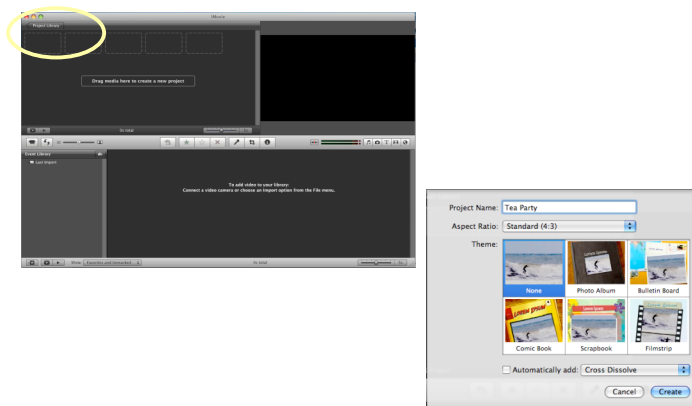
Importing images



Once all images have been gathered, add photos to your **iPhoto** gallery by dragging your images folder onto the **iPhoto** icon on the dock. iPhoto will open to reveal a new **Event**.

Once images have been imported, close iPhoto.

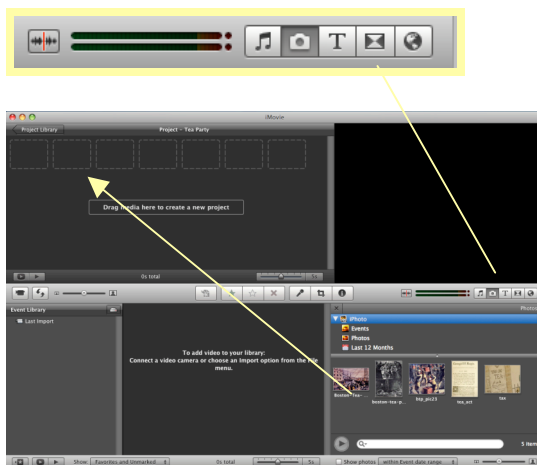
Creating a new project



Open iMovie 09 and enter the **Project Library** on the top left of the **Project Window**. Create a new project by clicking the plus sign at the bottom right of the **Project Library** panel.

Give your project a name and select **Standard (4:3)** for the **Aspect Ratio**. We will not be using templates.

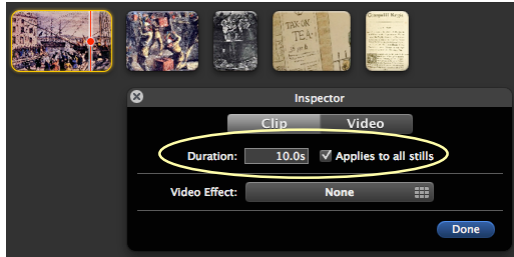
Adding images to project



Click on the camera icon below the Viewer to see iPhoto images in the **Media Browser** window.

Drag photos from the Media Browser into the Project Window in the desired order. Images can be re-ordered in the project by clicking and dragging.

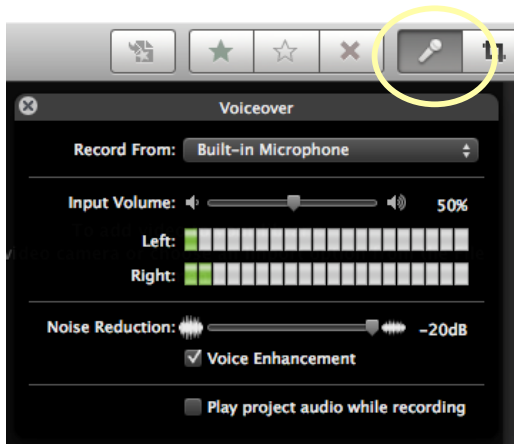
Changing image duration



Double click on any image in your Project Window to change its duration. Type in the desired number of seconds for one or all images in the project.

To begin, we will change the duration to 10 seconds and select **Apply to all stills**.

Adding voiceover

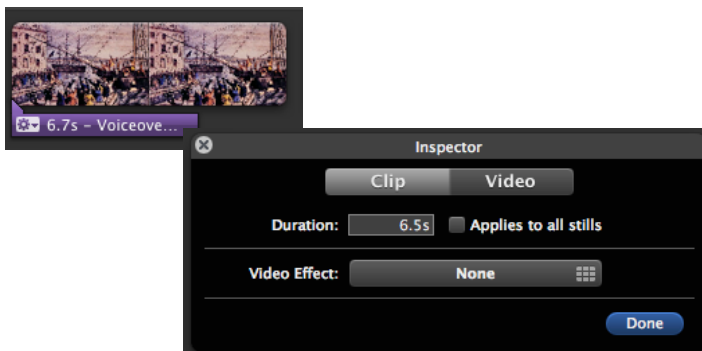


To begin recording your voiceover narration, click the microphone icon on the middle toolbar.

The **Voiceover** window will open, allowing you to test the volume of your voice and make audio adjustments.

Once settings have been adjusted, click on the beginning of the first image in the project window to begin narration. iMovie will give a 3 second warning before starting to record. Press the spacebar to end recording.

Fine-tuning image duration

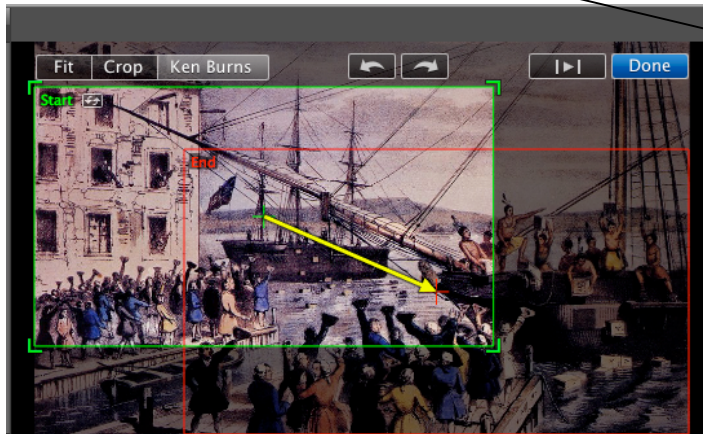
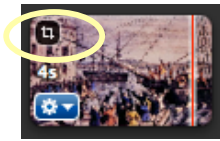


Recording narration in small sections will make it easier to align images with audio.

Double click each image to adjust duration.

*This time make sure to uncheck **Applies to all stills**

Ken Burns animation



Ken Burns animation is automatically applied to all stills when they are added to the Project Window but we will usually want to change the chosen settings.

Double click the crop icon on the image tile to reveal animation settings. In the **Viewer** we will set the scale and position of the image in the **Start** and **End** position.

Select the green rectangle to modify **Start** settings and the red rectangle to modify **End** settings.

Click **Done** when finished.

Adding Transitions



Click on the **Transition** icon in the Media Browser to view options.

To add a transition, drag from the Media Browser to the Project Window and drop between 2 image tiles.

Double click the transition icon in Project Window to adjust transition settings.

Adding titles

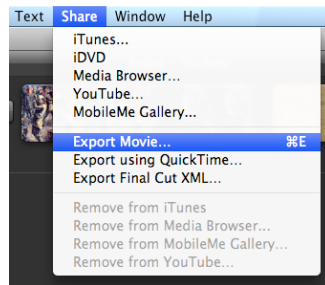


To add an intro title, click on the “T” icon in the Media Browser.

Select a style and drag tile into the desired position in the Project Window. Choose background color and click inside the Viewer to edit text.

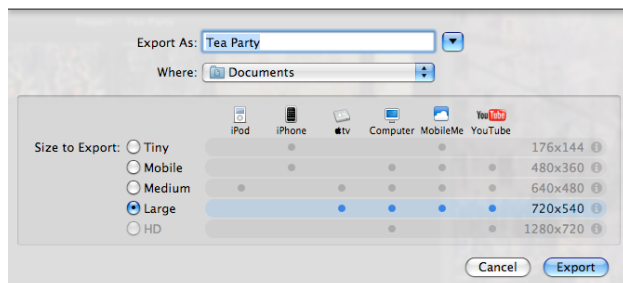
Double click on the title tile at any point to modify text or duration.

Exporting video



As videos exported for web will be compressed to a smaller size for faster streaming, we will always export a full size version as well for our archives.

Select the **Share** tab in the Task pane to view exporting options.



For a full size version, select **Large** and name your file.

For the web version, select **Mobile** and name your file.
