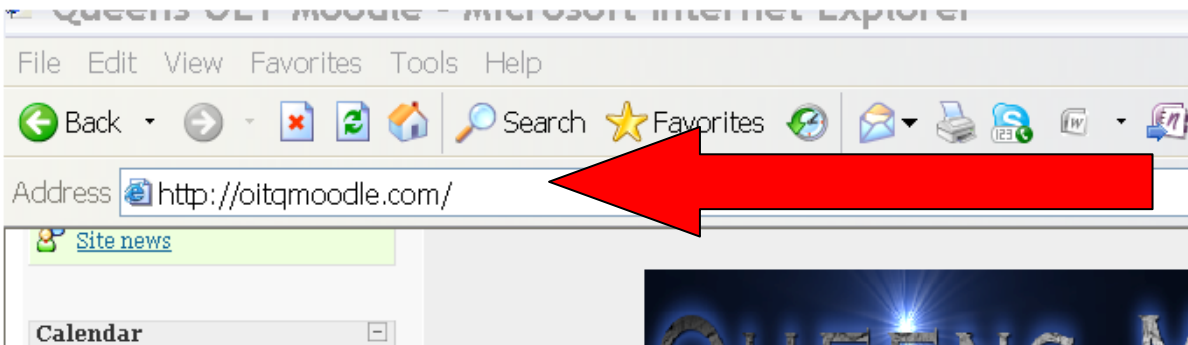
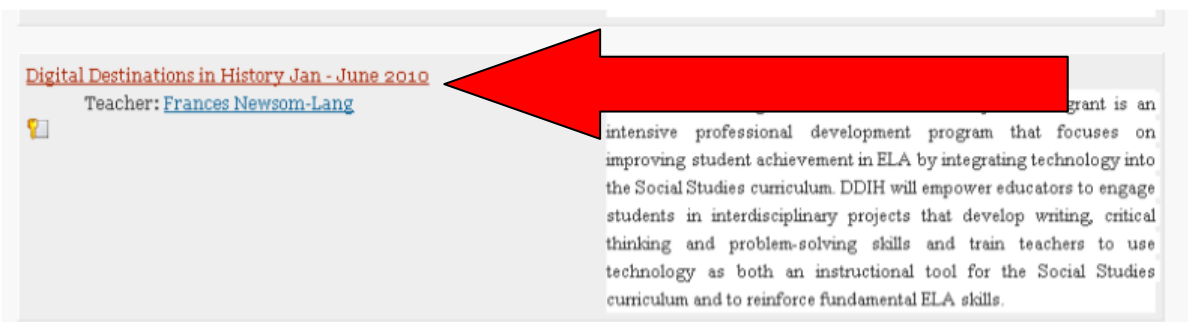


## Enrolling in a course on Moodle

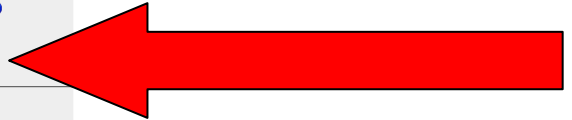
