

Center #3: Creating a ThingLink

1. Determine a photo or image that you want to use to represent the concept of scientific notation. This image should provide a lot of opportunities to ask questions, make conjectures, link other resources, etc.
2. Once you determine your image, make sure you have it saved on your device so you can load it onto the thinglink site.
3. Go to www.thinglink.com
4. Register for an account, if you don't have one.
5. Click the "Create" button.
6. Click the "choose images or drag and drop here" button to upload your image.
7. Once your image is uploaded, then you can select where you would like to link your information, questions or resources. Click anywhere to place your link. You can either type text --- for example, ask a great question about your image or you can link a resource that you have found or created.

Once you have made your link, then click the "save tag" button.

8. Try to make at least three different links with three different kinds of information or sources.
9. To get the link for your image, click the green "save" button.
