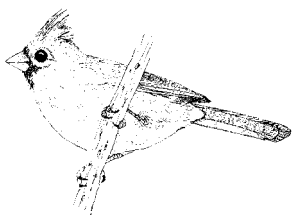


Story-Time Adventure: The Night Tree

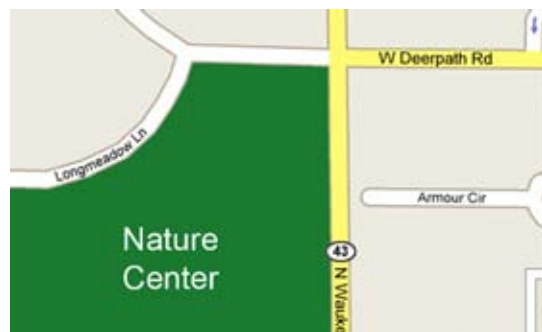

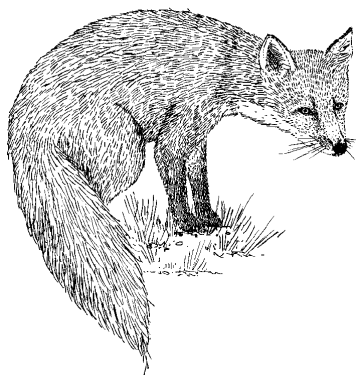
Discover the journey of seeds,

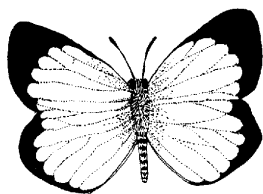


Parent and Tot Nature Explorers

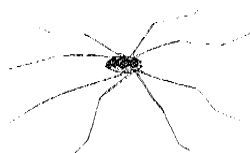

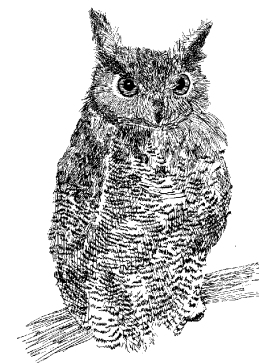


After-School Explorers
